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For the majority of courses, the University awards grades in categories associated with a numeric range and with a Grade Point Average (GPA) value. Courses that require competencies to be achieved to minimum specified levels, such as industry placement courses, may use the Ungraded Pass/Fail scheme rather than the University's numeric-based grading scheme. Courses may only have one grading scheme applied and this must be applied to all students in the course.

Grade	Range	GPA value	Descriptor
High Distinction (HD)	85-100	7	Evidence of an exceptional level of achievement of learning objectives across the entire content of the course demonstrated in such areas as interpretation and critical analysis, logical argument, creativity, originality, use of methodology and communication skills.
Distinction (DN)	75-84	6	Evidence of a high level of achievement of the learning objectives of the course demonstrated in such areas as interpretation and critical analysis, logical argument, use of methodology and communication skills.
Credit (CR)	65-74	5	Evidence of a good level of understanding, knowledge and skill development in relation to the content of the course or work

			of a superior quality on the majority of the learning objectives of the course. Demonstration of a high level of interpretation and critical analysis skills.
Pass (P)	50-64	4	Evidence of satisfactory achievement of course learning objectives, the development of relevant skills to a competent level, and adequate interpretation and critical analysis skills.
Ungraded Pass (UP)	n/a		Evidence of achievement of the minimum specified competencies for the course at a satisfactory level or better.
Fail (F1)	35-49	1	Evidence of unsatisfactory achievement of one or more of the learning objectives of the course, insufficient understanding of the course content and/or unsatisfactory level of skill development.
Fail (F2)	0-34	0	
Ungraded Fail (UF)	n/a		Evidence of unsatisfactory achievement of minimum specified competencies for the course.
Withdraw Fail (WF)		0	Student has withdrawn before completing the course.
