of up to 800 mt, we can guarantee reliable, efficient and flexible transport solutions tailored to our customers' specific needs.



attach great importance to the fact that BBC Chartering personnel are always close at hand.



and are certified to the ISO 9001:2008 quality management standard, the ISO 14001 environmental management standard, and the OHSAS 18001 occupational health and safety standard.



Our latest newbuildings are equipped with fuel consumption monitoring systems so that individual optimised eco speeds can be

calculated and kept to for each voyage. We have the hulls of our ships cleaned at regular intervals, and we are investing in research into alternative propulsion systems, hybrid technology and ultra-efficient hull designs. Excellence in health, safety and environmental matters is what we are always striving for.



Industry-leading flexibility in tramp and liner services

Our fleet of some 150 vessels covering 18 different classes of ship – one of the largest and most modern fleets of its kind in the world – gives our customers an unparalleled degree of flexibility since we are well placed to meet their every need. This flexibility is evident in our liner services where BBC Chartering vessels will pick

up cargoes on an inducement basis for other ports that are not on the normal route.

This is where our heavy lift tramp portfolio comes into its own. BBC Chartering vessels set sail for just one project cargo, calling in at various places en route to pick up project components. Our tramp vessels are certainly not confined to the conventional infrastructure of ports and

harbours. They have been known to take on or drop off cargo at unconventional wharfs or even the ice edge. Customers really appreciate such flexibility and the failsafe performance guaranteed by the size of our fleet.





The virtue of versatility: a fleet to meet your needs








With around 150 vessels in service, we operate the largest fleet of multipurpose heavy lift vessels afloat. It covers 18 classes of ship, ranges in size from 3,500 to 37,300 DWT, and can lift anything up to 800 metric tons. It is also an unusually young fleet with an average age of around four years – and that adds up to greater operational reliability and energy efficiency.

The characteristic shallow draft of our vessels means they are capable of carrying cargoes to virtually any port or harbour, or indeed offshore operation. And adjustable tweendecks allow

holds to be optimised to carry cargoes of differing dimensions, thus maximising efficiency and minimising wastage.

For you as a BBC customer another advantage of our fleet's diversity is that you get exactly the right kind of ship you need. Our fleet's size and versatility ensures the best possible value for money for our customers since we can always provide the right vessel for each and every cargo – whether break-bulk, heavy lift, project or bulk. plenty of back-up options. Concrete benefits from the virtue of versatility.



37,503mts dwat \cdot 4 x 30 mts cranes




17,500 mts dwat \cdot 3 x 80 mts cranes

20,567 mts dwat · 2 x 60 mts cranes





19,320 mts dwat \cdot 2 x 400 mts cranes + 1 x 120 mts crane





A fleet for the global marketplace - now and in future



By listening to your needs and responding to market trends, we will ensure that BBC Chartering continues to be strongly equipped to meet the changing demands of the global marketplace - now and in future.





14,800 mts dwat \cdot 2 x 400 mts cranes + 1 x 80 mts crane




BBC Everest

9 282 mts dwat - 2 x 350 mts crane





6,150 mts dwat · 2 x 60 mts cranes





12,780 mts dwat · 2 x 180 mts cranes





8,000 mts dwat · 2 x 80 mts cranes





4,325 mts dwat · 2 x 60 mts cranes




