Outline Description	Outer work
Property Description	The side walls which retained the earthen massif of the glacis have survived along the Saqqajja side of the land front and along a smaller section on the Gheriexem side of the front. In both instances, the lower portions of these walls appear to contain large, reutilized Roman blocks of masonry. A scarp musketry gallery is found in the upper part of the revetment within the counterscarp near and beneath the salient of D'Homedes Bastion.

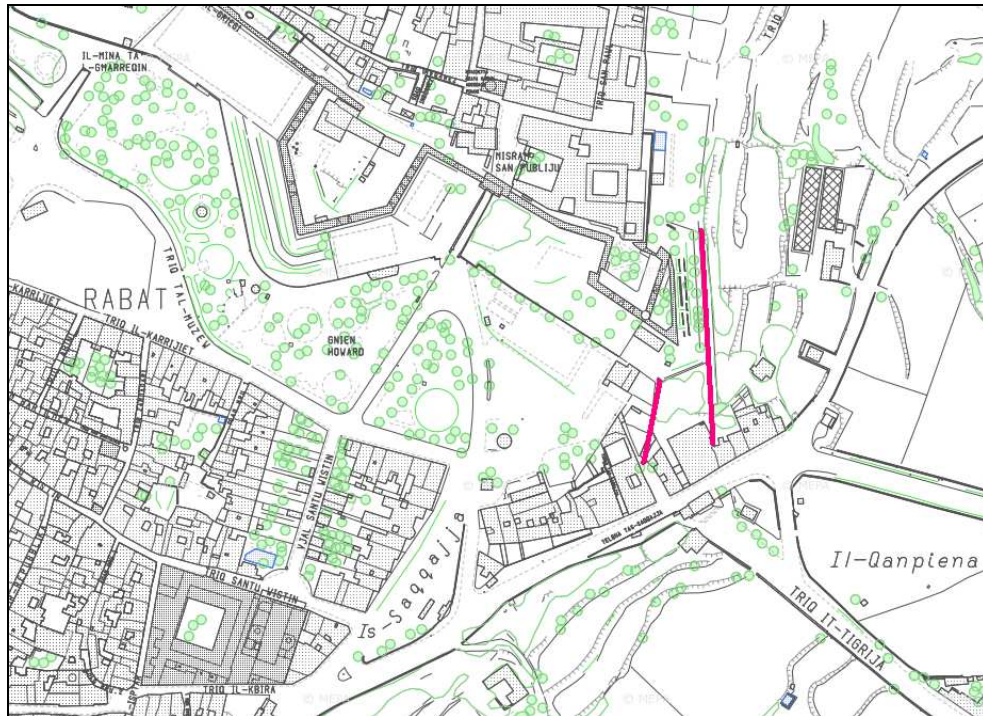
