Property Description	Nadur Tower is one of the coastal towers erected by Grand Master Lascaris in 1638. It was designed as a signalling tower intended to really warnings from the western coastline to Mdina. The tower is a small structure and appears to consist solely of he lower scarped half of an ordinary Lascaris coastal watchtower. Internally the tower consists a small room and a shaft leading up to the roof.

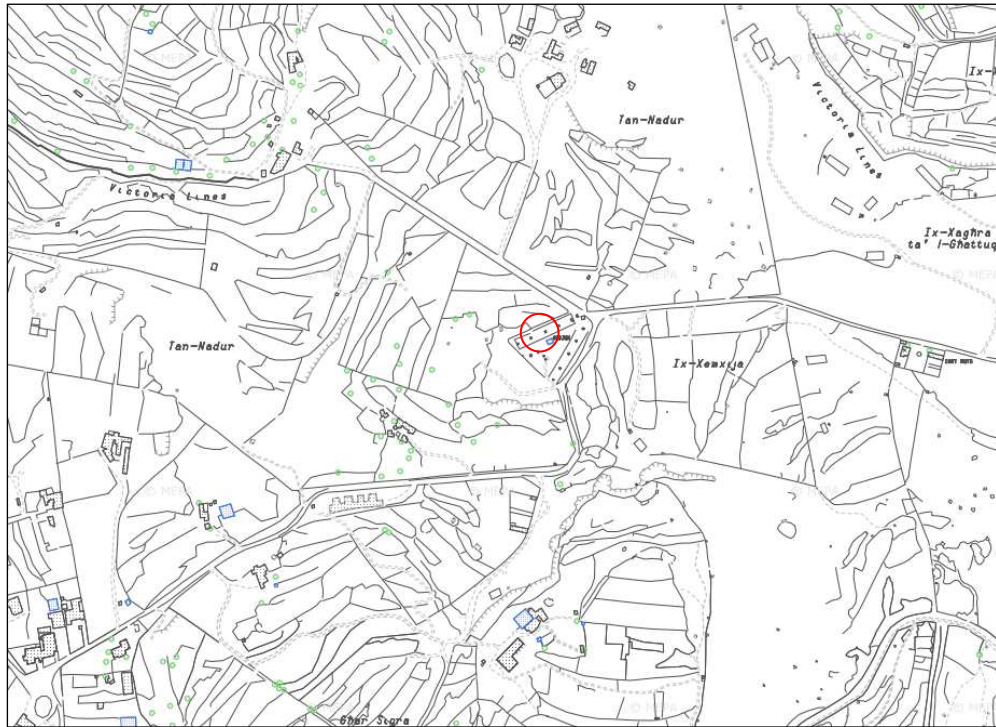
