

Outline Description	Coastal redoubt
Property Description	Baħar iċ-Ċagħaq Redoubt is one of the coastal works of fortification erected by the Knights in 1715/16. This structure consists of a pentagonal platform with short flanks and low parapet, closed off at the gorge by a rectangular blockhouse. The interior of the blockhouse is divided unequally into two rooms, the larger of the two containing the main entrance. The roof of the blockhouse is supported by spring arches and a dividing wall. A World War II defensive position was built onto the salient of the structure.
