Having lived in Israel and Palestine for a long time I got a chance to see the conflict through comedy and escapism. This short film is exactly how the Israelis and Palestinians would tell their history to each other. You'll see a new approach to the conflict, with a beautiful soundtrack, where I dare to cross the line and say the untold. Prepare yourself to laugh out loud, get shocked, disgusted, and educated. And since I come from an English-Irish Israeli-Palestinian background, I'm politically correct in whatever I say.

Basil Khalil: Producer / Director

Basil was born in the northern Israeli Palestinian town of Nazareth in 1981, where he lived until he was 18.

In 2000, after completing a diploma in television production in Canada, Basil landed his first film job as a production runner on the award winning Palestinian feature film "Divine Intervention". Basil tried to produce a few shorts in Israel, but the Intifada made it impossible. So in 2002 he moved to Scotland, there he got a diploma in 3D animation and an MA in Screen Project Development from Napier University.

In 2005, Basil formed Code 81 Films and produced his first feature documentary "Replay Revenge", which went on to play at a number of international film festivals.

Basil is in development of a slate of feature films and documentaries for television and theatrical release. One of his upcoming features in development is "The Flying Carpet Regiment", a satire documentary on Iraq's secret flying carpet weapon.

A lecturer in Digital filmmaking, editor and D.O.P; specializing in extreme condition photography, Ronnie has a background of rally racing, farming, animal wrangling, engineering and can practically do anything, except spelling!
