Federal Politics in Canada

This poll was conducted online in all regions of Canada with a representative sample of 1,511 Canadians, between March $25^{\text {th }}$ and March $28^{\text {th }}$, 2013.

Final data were weighted by age, gender, language, level of education and household composition (with or without children under the age of 18) in order to obtain a representative sample of the Canadian population.

A probabilistic sample of 1,511 respondents would yield a margin of error of $2,5 \%, 19$ times out of 20.

Survey respondents were selected randomly from the LegerWeb Internet panel, which is comprised of over 400,000 Canadian households. A stratification process was applied to invitation lists to ensure optimal representation of respondents. Panelists were recruited randomly during Leger Marketing telephone surveys. Several quality control measures ensure the representativeness and accuracy of Leger Marketing's surveys with its panel members.

In the tables, numbers in bold red indicate a significantly higher proportion than that of other groups. Numbers in bold blue indicate a significantly lower proportion than that of other groups.

## Federal Voting Intentions by Region

The
Conservative Party is ahead in Western Canada, while Conservatives
(33\%) and Liberals (34\%) are tied in Ontario.

The NDP now ranks third in Quebec (24\%), behind the
Bloc
Québecois (29\%) and the Liberals (28\%).

## Federal Voting Intentions With Justin Trudeau as Leader of the Liberal Party of Canada

If Justin Trudeau were leader of the Liberal Party of Canada, the liberals would have $37 \%$ of voting intentions in Canada, and $32 \%$ in Québec.
