### METHODOLOGY NOTE

ComRes interviewed 1,105 British adults aged 18+ by telephone from 11th-14th February, including 201 Scottish adults. Data were weighted to be representative of all GB adults aged 18+. Data were also weighted by past vote recall. ComRes is a member of the British Polling Council and abides by its rules.
