My vision of the World Summit on the Information Society Adama Samassékou



The World Summit on the Information Society is a unique platform, which brings together, for the first time in the history of the United Nations system, all stakeholders as partners to address a significant societal challenge. Our objective is to collectively build a people-centred, inclusive and development oriented Information Society, where everyone can create, access, utilize and share information and knowledge, enabling individuals, communities and peoples to achieve their full potential in promoting their sustainable development and improving their quality of life.

Since the very beginning of the preparatory process of this new type of Summit, which I have the honour to chair, I have been convinced that the world is entering a new era of enormous potential for all individuals. In this emerging society, information and knowledge can be produced and communicated through all the networks of the world and all citizens can soon, if we take the necessary actions, share their ideas, knowledge and know-how to improve their common well being.

My personal vision is that we can together build, through the World Summit on the Information Society, a new global solidarity founded on a better mutual understanding between peoples and nations, of a shared knowledge society for the future. The World Summit Award will help us make this vision a reality by raising awareness of the enormous creative potential of information and communication technologies and by promoting, by its work, a global evolution from an information society to a shared knowledge society.

Let us therefore work together to ensure that this first Summit of the third millennium, this World Summit of Solidarity, contributes to making the information society - the offspring of the digital revolution - a genuine society of human communication and shared knowledge, this being a sine qua non for a new global dialogue for peace and a new kind of international communication, founded on a greater readiness to listen and on dialogue, sharing and active solidarity between the nations and citizens of our planet. I thank and congratulate the initiators of the World Summit Award, in particularly Professor Peter A. Bruck, and all its partners, for their most important work for our common future.

Adama Samassékou has a distinguished career in Mali, Africa and on the global stage. He is President of PrepCom of WSIS, President of the African Academy of Languages and former Minister of Education of Mali (1993-2000)
