New Turanian Species of the Narrow-Winged Pyraloid Moths (Lepidoptera, Phycitidae) Associated with Chenopodiaceae

Abstract—8 new species are described. The material studied was reared from larvae: Christophia tessulata sp. n. on Caroxylon orientalis, Ch. leucosiphon sp. n. on Haloxylon ammodendron, Ch. eriopodae sp. n. on Anabasis eriopoda, Ch. climacopterae sp. n. on Climacoptera crassa, Ch. triceratops sp. n. on Climacoptera spp., Ch. ammobia sp. n. on Haloxylon spp. and Xylosalsola richteri, and Prorophora halothamni sp. n. on Halothamnus subaphyllus. A list of species reared by the author in the Kyzylkum desert from different representatives of the family Chenopodiaceae is given together with notes on host plants and their consumed parts.
