

HIS is the oldest honorary scholarship society in the United States, having been founded at William and Mary College, Virginia, in 1776. There are now about 40,000 living members in over ninety chapters. The society aims to promote scholarship in the liberal arts. The Delta Chapter of Maine was established at the University of Maine College of Arts and Sciences in 1923. Elections from the Senior Class are made on the basis of scholarship, breadth of culture, and general promise. Not more than ten per cent of the class are eligible for election.
