6.3	Bletchley Football Club at Manor Fields Manor Fields Renovation (football ground & Stands) The Town Council granted £9,000 in 2010 for this project. Bletchley Town Football Club has disbanded but local people are currently looking into reforming the club. At the present time, Buckingham Town Football Club are using Manor Fields. Where they used to play in Buckingham the owner of the land sold it with a view to using it for housing (but was then not able to get planning permission). The land has now been purchase by Buckingham University and the plan is to reinstate the area for use by the University as a playing field. The plan is for Buckingham Town FC to move back to Buckingham and play on the University fields.
