Number of Population is Increasing

As of January 1, 2012 the population of Georgia increased by 28.4 thousand persons (0.6 percent) and equaled 4,497.6 thousand persons¹, of which 53.2 percent (2,391.7 thousand persons) live in urban area and 46.8 percent (2,105.9 thousand persons) in rural area.

(Thousand persons)


