KEY QUALIFICATIONS

Hans Askov Jensen has been involved in the poultry sector since 1959. After his graduation in 1969, he has conducted research work with emphasis on poultry breeding following a period of 10 years, where he was employed in the private poultry sector in Denmark, covering subjects as breeding, management, feeding and organisation. Since 1980 he has been associated with poultry production abroad, mainly in the developing countries, from where he has experience from more than 80 missions to Africa, Far and Near East and Central America. The experiences cover small-scale poultry holdings as well as more commercialised projects.

He has special experience in planning and implementation of village poultry programmes, based on a semi-scavenging concept as an integral part of poverty alleviation and rural development programmes.

Since 1993 he has been involved in development and dissemination of a smallholder poultry concept with the poorest segment of the village population as the target group. The concepts encompass 1) Smallholder poultry activities, 2) Micro credit, 3) Community group formations, and 4) institutional capacity buildings. The concept has been developed in Bangladesh over the past 15 years and the main NGO involved has an annual capacity to establish 200,000 families with smallholder poultry and other income generating activities.
