MCC works to promote a decent and dignified life for small scale farmers, with water and food security and land ownership rights. In 2008, MCC took part in the Minga of Social and Community Resistance where a public debate was held with the President and was followed by a walk from the south of the country to the capital Bogotá. In the process around 50,000 people, including members of the indigenous community, students, trade unionists, women and residents of urban areas joined.
