


Witness for Peace Southeast presents The Colombian Speaker's Tour October 2-24, 2011

In 2008, MCC took part in the Minga of Social and Community Resistance where a public debate was held with the President and was followed by a walk from the south of the country to the capital Bogota. In the process around 50,000 people, including members of the indigenous community, students, trade unionists, women and residents of urban areas joined.
