Quick Facts:

- Princeton is one of four charter members of the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association, which was founded in 1905.
- In addition to 11 Ivy titles, the team has won three EIWA titles (1911, 1941 and 1978) and has appeared in NCAA postseason team competition twice (1978 and 1985). The 1978 team finished 14th at the tournament while the 1985 team finished 18th.
- One Princeton wrestler has captured a national individual title. Bradley Glass '53 won the individual championship in the unlimited weight division in 1951. Emil Deliere '72, John Sefter '78, John Orr '85 and Greg Parker '03 (2002) all placed second in the NCAA Tournament. (Orr placed second in 1984 and 1985).
- Four Princeton wrestlers were named outstanding wrestler of the EIWA Tournament: Charlie Powers '38 (1937), Bob Eberle '41 (1941), John Orr '85 (1984) and Greg Parker '03 (2003)
- The only three wrestlers to earn first-team All-Ivy League honors four times were all from Princeton: Keith Ely '79, John Orr '85 and Dave Crisanti '86.
- Jadwin Gym has hosted numerous regional and national collegiate wrestling championships, including the 1969, 1979, 1981 and 1987 EIWA championships and the 1975 and 1981 NCAA Tournaments.
