Descendants of Ferdinando Leigh

Ferdinando Leigh emigrated from England about 1740, before the Revolution. He married Martha Cole, widow of Thomas West, owner of West Point, Virginia, among the upper crust of Virginia society. He was, of course, a Tory during the Revolution and this estranged him for awhile from his son William who was an ardent "patriot".

The family has produced some notable figures who are detailed in this Genealogy Report. To follow standard practice the report has been truncated to avoid revealing names and details concerning the living. The portrait above is of his grandson, Benjamin Watkins Leigh.

DNA tests now underway are tending to support the belief that Ferdinando Leigh and Col. William Leigh had a close common ancestor. This would perhaps explain Ferdinando's warm welcome into King William County.

1. Ferdinando¹ **Leigh**, b. 1716, in England, d. 30 Oct 1779, in Dinwiddie Co., Virginia. Married Martha Cole about 1746, in West Point, Virginia. She was the daughter of Col. William Cole, Jr. and Mary Roscow. Martha Cole was b. 1711, d. 16 Apr 1770.

Notes for Ferdinando Leigh: I have seen the date of this Ferdinando's immigration from England as 1743, 1745 and 1732-38. He married Thomas West's widow, nee Martha Cole, and settled at West Point, King William County, Virginia. It is highly likely that "West Point" was named by the West family. When a town was laid out there it became "Delaware" (de la Warr?) briefly but then reverted to West Point. Lots in this town are an important connection for Gilbert Leigh of North Carolina.

I have seen Ferdinando's date of death given as 1769 also; however, his will is dated May24, 1779 and it is recorded in May 1784. The following death notice appears authentic, however.

"Mr. Ferdinando Leigh, near Petersburg, in the sixty-fourth year of his age. October 30" William and Mary College Quarterly Historical Magazine, Vol. 12, No. 1.(Jul., 1903), pp. 25-28. PERSONAL NOTICES FROM THE "VIRGINIA GAZETTE." (February 12, 1779 - December 25, 1779.):

I have seen one source, documented by the Historical Society of Virginia, which claims that Ferdinando did not immigrate but that he was the son of John Leigh of King William County and grandson of Col. William Leigh of King William County. This is inconsistent with other records which say that the native Ferdinando Leigh was the son of William Leigh who was the second son of Col. William Leigh of King and Queen County and John Leigh's brother.

From the Benleigh FTM file: Note from Dick Purser. I corrected this name from Fernando Leigh to Ferdinando Leigh. This is based on a death notice for Ferdinando Leigh published in the Virginia Gazette on 30 October 1779. He is noted to have died near Petersburg, Virginia in the 64th year of his age. His estate is in the hands of William Claiborne, Sr. of Petersburg (Virginia Gazette, 19 February, 1780) and his heir at law is said to be William Leigh of Chesterfield County, Virginia.(Virginia Gazette or American Advertiser, 12 July 1783)

Notes for Martha Cole: Name could be Martha or Mary. She is named Mary in one place and Martha in another.

Notes for Benjamin Watkins Leigh: Lawyer, Senator from Virginia, Author of Leigh's Reports. Extensive information available.

He is credited with three wives. His marriages to Mary Selden Watkins, Susanna Colston, and Julia Wickham were each to admirable women from notable Virginia families. He had sons by all of them and in this data base there are I think 8 Benjamin Watkins Leigh's. I know of two more.

Notes for Mary Selden Watkins: The date of Thomas Leigh's birth and Mary Watkins Leigh's death are obscure. It appears likely that she died during chilbirth and that Senator Leigh re-married quickly, partly to have someone to care for his son.

Notes for Thomas Watkins Leigh: There is more than a little question in my mind as to whether this Thomas W. Leigh is Benjamin Watkins Leigh's son or his nephew. It is a bit difficult to fit him into BWL's marriages. This Thomas went on to become a circuit judge in Halifax County just like his uncle (or father). On the other hand, BWL's son William did name a son Thomas.

Added note: In Benjamin Watkins will dated October, 1817 and executed in September, 1825 in Chesterfield County, Va. he refers to his Nephew Thomas W. Leigh, "son of my late sister" (Mary Selden Watkins) and also to his sister Mrs. William Leigh (Rebecca). His brothers in law Bej. W. Leigh and William Leigh are executors along with his brothers Thomas and Miles. This seems to be definitive that Thomas W. is Mary Selden Watkins' son.

Notes for William Leigh: William Leigh was a Lt. in the US Navy 1828-1852 by appointment from Virginia. When Virginia seceded he resigned and took a commission as a Major in the CSA.

The Colston family beginning with Rawleigh owned lands in Berkeley County, Virginia. William Leigh's data indicates he was born at Falling Waters, Berkeley County, Va. This is an area close to the headwaters of the Potomac. Rawleigh Colston's land was in Berkeley County on the Potomac and it is likely that William was born on land Benjamin Watkins Leigh received from Rawleigh Colston after he married Susanna Colston. Apparently after Susanna's death, Benjamin Watkins Leigh gave the land to William.
