


UNLV CAREER

Adams begins his second season with the Runnin' Rebels in 2006-07 ... appears in the UNLV record books after tying the mark for most steals in a game when he recorded eight vs. Colorado State on Jan. 18, 2006.

FRESHMAN (2005-06)

Earned honorable mention for the All-Mountain West Conference teams ... appeared in all 30 of UNLV's games and started 20 ... played an average of 28.3 minutes per game with averages of 10.9 ppg, 3.3 rpg, 2.4 apg and 2.1 spg ... shot 40.7 percent from the field, 33.3 percent from 3-point range and 72.3 percent from the free throw line ... was second in the MWC in steals, 16th in assists, 18th in 3-pointers made and 19th in scoring ... led UNLV in steals, was second in assists, second in points scored, third in scoring average, third in 3-point-

ers made and fourth in rebounding ... tied for 58th in the country in steals per game ... scored in double figures in 16 games and scored 20 or more points three times ... scored a career-high 23 points on 9of-11 from the field with five steals and four assists vs. BYU ... recorded eight steals vs. Colorado State ... led UNLV in scoring in six games ... made at least one 3-pointer in 21 games.
