## **BAL SAHITYA PURASKAR 2013**

Chennai, 23 August 2013. Nine books of stories, two of poetry, one of novel, one of essays, one of plays, one collection of essays with poetry and nine writers for their Total Contribution to Children Literature have won the Bal Sahitya Puraskar this year.

The Awards were recommended by distinguished Jury members representing 24 Indian languages and approved by the Executive Board of the Sahitya Akademi which met today under the Chairmanship of Dr. Vishwanath Prasad Tiwari, President of the Sahitya Akademi.

Those who have won the Awards for their collection of stories include Narayan Debnath (Bengali), Jatindra Nath Swargiary (Bodo), Krishan Sharma (Dogri), Raghu Leishangthem (Manipuri), Vimla Bhandari (Rajasthani), Vasudev 'Nirmal' (Sindhi), Revathy (E.S. Hariharan) (Tamil), D. Sujatha Devi (Telugu) and Asad Raza (Urdu).

Those who have won the Awards for their collection of poetry include Ramesh Tailang (Hindi) and Sari Dharam Hansda (Santali). Dhirendra Kumar Jha (Maithili) for his book of essays has been honoured. H.R. Vishvasa for his book of plays has been honoured. Maya Anil Kharangate for her novel and Rashid Kanispori for his collection of essays with poetry has been honoured.

Toshaprabha Kalita (Assamese), Anita Nair (English), Shraddha Trivedi (Gujarati), H.S. Venkateshmurthy (Kannada), Sumangala (Leela Namboothiripad) (Malayalam), Anant Bhave (Marathi), Bhotu Pradhan (Nepali), Nadiya Bihari Mohanty (Odia) and Kamaljit Neelon (Punjabi) are among those honoured with the Bal Sahitya Puraskar 2013 for their Total Contribution to Children Literature.

The books and writers for their total contribution were selected on the basis of recommendations made by a Jury of three members in the concerned languages in accordance with the procedure laid down for the purpose. According to the procedure, the Executive Board declared the Awards on the basis of unanimous selection made by the Jurors or selection made on the basis of majority vote. The Awards relate to books first published during the five years immediately preceding the year of Award (i.e., between 1 January 2007 and 31 December 2011). However, during the initial five years i.e. from 2010 to 2014, the award may be given to an author based on his/her total contribution to Children Literature if no book is considered suitable for the award.

The Award in the form of a casket containing an engraved copper-plaque, shawl and a cheque of Rs. 50,000/- will be presented to the awardees at a special function to be held on 15 November 2013 at Goa.
