POETS DOMINATE SAHITYA AKADEMI AWARDS 2014

New Delhi, 19 December 2014. Eight books of poetry, five of novels, three of essays, three of short stories, one each of literary criticism, autobiography and play have won the Sahitya Akademi Award this year.

The Awards were recommended by distinguished Jury members representing 22 Indian languages and approved by the Executive Board of the Sahitya Akademi which met today under the Chairmanship of Dr. Vishwanath Prasad Tiwari, President of the Sahitya Akademi. Manipuri and Sanskrit language awards will be declared later on.

Famous poets honoured with the Award for the year 2014 are Utpal Kumar Basu (Bengali), Urkhao Gwra Brahma (Bodo), Adil Jussawalla (English), Shad Ramzan (Kashmiri), Gopalkrushna Rath (Odia), Jaswinder (Punjabi), Gope Kamal (Sindhi) and Munawwar Rana (Urdu).

The well-known novelists Shailender Singh (Dogri), Ramesh Chandra Shah (Hindi), Subhash Chandran, (Malayalam) Asha Mishra (Maithili) and Poomani (Tamil) are among those honoured with the Sahitya Akademi Awards 2014.

(Late) Ashvin Mehta (Gujarati), G.H. Nayak (Kannada) and Madhavi Sardesai (Konkani) have got the Award for their books of essays. Arupa Patangia Kalita (Assamese), Nanda Hankhim (Nepali) and Rampal Singh Rajpurohit (Rajasthani) have got the Award for their books of short stories. Jayant Vishnu Naralikar (Marathi) for his autobiography, Jamadar Kisku (Santali) for his play and Rachapalem Chandrashekara Reddy (Telugu) for his literary criticism have been honoured.

The books were selected on the basis of recommendations made by a Jury of three members in the concerned languages in accordance with the procedure laid down for the purpose. According to the procedure, the Executive Board declared the Awards on the basis of unanimous selections made by the Jurors or selection made on the basis of majority vote. The Awards relate to books first published during the three years immediately preceding the year of Award (i.e., between 1 January 2010 and 31 December 2012).

The Award in the form of a casket containing an engraved copperplaque, a shawl and a cheque of \raiset 1,00,000/- will be presented to the authors of these books at a special function to be held on 9 March 2015 at New Delhi during the Festival of Letters organized by Sahitya Akademi.
