

STATISTICS AND TARIFF INFORMATION IN TELECOM SECTOR AS OF JUNE 2015

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PRELIMINARY REMARKS

- The information compiled in this report is from telecom companies and Internet Service Providers.
- Subscription in this report is defined as active subscribers that have generated revenue within three months of the quarter under review.

SUMMARY

This is a second quarter report for 2015; it covers the period from March 2015 to June 2015. This report includes information on mobile telephone, fixed telephone, internet, tariff (voice call tariff, and data tariff), traffic, revenues, investment and employment in telecommunication sector.

In the period under review, the mobile telephone subscriptions increased from 7,913,986 recorded in the first quarter 2015 to 8,181,993 as of the second quarter 2015. This portrays a 3% increase. Mobile telephone penetration rate rose to 72.6% as compared to 72.3% recorded at the end of the previous quarter.

Fixed telephone subscriptions in this quarter fell by 5.3% from 48,931 recorded in the first quarter 2015 to 46,465 recorded in this quarter under review. This decrease in fixed telephone subscribers is attributed to CDMA telephones in up country that have continued to be disconnected by Liquid telecom Ltd.

On internet data segment, the number of internet subscriptions as of June 2015 is 3,542,835 from 3,140,310. This represents internet penetration rate of 12.8%.

MOBILE AND FIXED TELEPHONE SUBSCRIPTIONS

As of June 2015, operators offering mobile telephony services included MTN Rwanda Ltd, TIGO Rwanda Ltd and AIRTEL Rwanda Ltd, and those offering fixed telephone services were Liquid Telecom Ltd and MTN Rwanda Ltd.



The number of fixed telephones subscriptions decreased from 48,931 recorded in the first quarter to 46,465 recorded in the second quarter, this decrease is mainly due to CDMA Fixed telephones disconnection up country.

According to figure 1, Mobile telephone subscriptions as of June 2015 were 8,181,993 from 7,913,986 subscribers for the 1st quarter 2015. This shows an increase of 3%. The increase is mainly attributed to Burundian refugees, promotional tariffs and calling packs and airtime, popularity of mobile based applications such as social media and financial applications, together with mobile network roll out.

Figure 2: Development of fixed telephone Subscribers



MTN Rwanda Ltd continued to show the biggest market share in the second quarter 2015 of 49%, Tigo Rwanda followed with 35 % recorded in June 2015 and Airtel Rwanda has the least market share of 16%.




Figure 4. Fixed telephone service Market share per operator as of June 2015

Liquid Telecom Ltd continued to dominate the fixed telephone market in the June 2015 with a market share of over 67%, followed by MTN Rwanda Ltd with a 33% market share.

Geographically MTN 2G and 2.5 Network covers 99.08% of the total land area, followed by Airtel Rwanda Ltd with 89.73 % and 88.98% for TIGO Rwanda. This geographic network gives the opportunity to 99.9% of the population to access 2G and 2.5G networks of MTN Rwanda Ltd, 99.83% of TIGO Network and 91.56% of AIRTEL network.

3G and 3.5G mobile technologies were deployed geographically by MTN Rwanda Ltd at the level of 64.49%, Tigo Rwanda Ltd at 12.35%, and 15.36% for Airtel Rwanda Ltd as of June 2015.





Figure 6: Fixed telephone service tariff structure



Figure 8. Trend in total internet Subscribers as of June 2015




Figure 9. Internet penetration rate trend as of June 2015



Figure 10: Mobile Internet Subscribers market share as of the last two quarters 2015





Figure 11: Fixed broadband internet subscribers market share for the last two quarters 2015


