Municipal Corporation of greater Mumbai, as one of its functions, provides Medical relief to citizens of Mumbai, in order to provide Medical Relief services to citizens of suburban areas of Mumbai. MCGM has 16 peripheral hospital in different areas of Mumbai. K.B. Bhabha Municipal General Hospital is situated in Belgrami Road, near Bharat Cinema in kurla (w) in Eastern Suburbs. It is one of such peripheral hospital. Its mission is to provide all necessary secondary level referral health care services to people of extended Eastern Suburbs.

In the late thirties, there was no civic or government hospital in the eastern suburbs of Mumbai which stretched from Karjat to Kurla. In 1885, there was a small dispensary by the name of Kavasgi Jahangir Dispensary and was under the control of Kurla Municipal Bureau.

In 1935, Municipal Corporation began with a 30 bedded maternity home & named as Khan Bahadur Hospital. This maternity home converted into General Hospital in 1950, with addition of out patient department. The department of Medicine, Surgery, Paediatrics , X-ray, pathology, incorporated from 1962. There after other facilities were added to the hospital. Bhabha hospital Kurla, became one of the secondary level hospital with present bed strength of 306 with all general facilities.
