ALLOCATION OF QUALIFICATION	The qualification slot is allocated to the NPC, not to the team.
MAXIMUM QUOTA ALLOCATION PER NPC	An NPC can be allocated no more than one (1) men's team qualification slot and one (1) women's team qualification slot.
ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY	To be eligible for selection by an NPC, athletes must: • Have competed in at least one international IBSA Goalball competition between 1 January 2010 and 31 January 2012; and • Be internationally classified with a 'Confirmed' sport class status.
MAXIMUM ENTRY PER NPC	An NPC can enter a maximum of one (1) men's team comprised of six (6) eligible male athletes and one (1) women's team comprised of six (6) eligible female athletes.

DATES / PROCESS OF CONFIRMATION OF QUALIFICATION SLOTS

By 26 March 2012, each NPC must confirm in writing (fax and e-mails are accepted) to IBSA the number of team qualification slots they will use. NPCs that have not replied by this date will have lost their team qualification slots, and IBSA may reallocate these slots.

By 09 April 2012, IBSA will confirm in writing the reallocation of all unused team qualification slots.

By 09 April 2012, it is officially declared that the respective NPCs will use the allocated quota granted for the London 2012 Paralympic Games. Any NPC that does not use some or all team qualification slots allocated may be subject to sanctions by the IPC and IBSA.

REALLOCATION OF UNUSED QUALIFICATION SLOTS

Slots allocated at the 2010 IBSA Goalball World Championships

Any team qualification slots earned at the 2010 IBSA Goalball World Championships and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked team from the World Championships, not otherwise qualified.

Slots allocated at the 2011 IBSA Goalball Regional Championships

Any team qualification slots earned at a 2011 IBSA Goalball Regional Qualifier and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked team from the Regional Championships, not otherwise qualified.

Slots allocated at the 2011 IBSA Goalball Paralympic Qualification Tournament

Any team qualification slots earned at a 2011 IBSA Goalball Paralympic Qualification Tournament and not used by the respective NPC will be reallocated to the NPC of the next highest ranked team from the qualifier, not otherwise qualified.

Slots allocated to Host Country

Any team qualification slots allocated to the host country and not used by the host country will be reallocated to the highest ranked team from the 2010 IBSA Goalball World Championships, not otherwise qualified.
