**COMPLETION OF FIRE HALL RENOVATIONS AND ACQUISITION
OF TWO NEW FIRE TRUCKS**

Regina, SK (November 14, 2012): Regina Airport Authority invites you to join us for a brief program and facility tour as we celebrate the completion of our Fire Hall renovations and welcome two new firefighting vehicles to Regina International Airport.

The expansion to the fire hall, designed by Stantec and constructed by Westridge, was two-fold, as upgrades to accommodate the recently acquired fire trucks as well as repairs to the existing facility were required. Two new Rosenbauer Panther 6 x 6 fire trucks arrived this past fall, and, upon completion of the required training, RAA firefighters will be ready to take to the runways with these new vehicles.

As with all of Regina Airport Authority's projects, the fire hall upgrades and the addition of the new vehicles ensure Regina International Airport is able to meet our current needs while allowing for potential expansion and capacity well into the future. These improvements and additions are part of our continued focus and a key aspect in enhancing all activities associated with operating "your airport".
