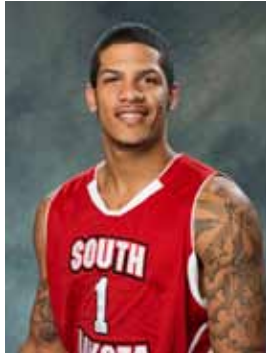

## Head Coach Dave Boots



Coaching legend Dave Boots is in his 25th season as South Dakota's men's basketball coach. Boots has amassed more than 600 head coaching victories and established himself as one of the most outstanding coaches in the nation.

After developing the Coyotes into one of the premier teams at the NCAA Division II level, Boots helped USD find success in its four years of transitioning to NCAA Division I status.

Since his arrival in Vermillion in 1988, Boots has recorded the most wins ever by a head men's basketball coach at the school, posting a 493-215 record for a winning percentage of .696. Named USD's 15th head coach in April 1988, Boots has won numerous honors, including being named conference coach of the year seven times.

A highly respected coach, Boots has been a collegiate head coach for 31 years, posting a record of 608-278 (.686). During his career, he has led the Coyotes to 16, 20-win seasons. Boots earned his 600th win -- becoming the 64th coach in men's basketball history to reach the milestone -- with a 69-63 win over Tabor on Nov. 28, 2011.

Boots, who also serves as assistant athletic director at USD, led the Coyotes to six NCC championships (1992-93, 1993-94, 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2000-01 and 2006-07), two North Central Region crowns (1992-93, 1993-94) and two appearances in the NCAA Division II Elite 8 National Tournament (1992-93, 1993-94). He continued that at the Division I level with a Great West Conference regular-season and tournament title in 2010.

Boots guided USD to 10 NCAA Division II national tournament appearances, including five straight (2003-08), and continued that

with a berth in the CollegelInsider.com Postseason Tournament in 2010. The Coyotes were consistently ranked among the Top-25 in Division II.

The veteran mentor guided a Coyote team into its first year in the Summit League in 2011-12. The Coyotes battled through a difficult league schedule to finish eighth in the standings after being picked 10th in the preseason coaches poll. A big highlight was a thrilling 72-68 win over eventual league tournament champion South Dakota State on Feb. 9 in front of 5,189 fans at the DakotaDome.

Boots guided a Coyote team with three new starters and several new faces to the Great West Conference championship game in 2010-11. The Coyotes reached the 18-win plateau thanks to a late 6-2 surge to close the season, including a key 72-70 win over regular-season champion Utah Valley in the GWC tournament semifinals.

South Dakota also earned a watershed victory when the Coyotes beat Mountain West Conference foe Wyoming on Dec. 1. The win was the Coyotes' biggest since the move to Division I. Charlie Westbrook was named All-GWC first team and to the all-newcomer team, while Louie Krogman was All-GWC second team.

In 2009-10, Boots continued that success with an impressive run during USD's first season in the Great West Conference. The Coyotes notched a 22-10 record, including 11-1 in the league, before capturing the GWC tournament title to earn an appearance against Creighton in the CollegelInsider.com Postseason tournament. Boots was named GWC Coach of the Year, while Tyler Cain claimed GWC MVP and defensive player of the year honors. Roman Gentry joined Cain on the first-team All-GWC, while Jake Thomas was all-newcomer and Louie Krogman was the GWC Sixth Man of the Year.

In 2008-09, during their first year of transition to NCAA Division I status, Boots guided the Coyotes to a 20-9 record, which was the sixth straight year USD has reached the 20-win mark. The Coyotes also finished 14-1 at home as they continued their dominance at the DakotaDome under Boots. USD also recorded its first win over a Division I foe since making the jump to Division I status with a 74-66 win at New Orleans on Dec. 28, 2008. In addition, USD recorded five wins over Division I foes and posted a 15-game winning streak during the season.

During 2007-08, he led the Coyotes to a 22-7 record, including a 7-5 mark (third) in the final year of the NCC. The team was invited to the NCAA Division II playoffs for a school-record, fifth-straight season. Boots was selected North Central Conference Coach of the Year six times and named Kodak District Coach of the Year three times during his time at DII.

In 2006-07, Boots directed the Coyotes to a 23-7 mark, a total which ranked fourth-best in school history, matching the 1998-99 team's effort. He led USD to its 12th NCC title in school history. Boots' squad captured the tournament title with a 97-86 win over Minnesota State in the tournament championship game held at the DakotaDome.

Prior to Boots' arrival, the Coyotes had not experienced a winning season since 1978-79. By comparison, USD's 23 consecutive winning seasons was the longest streak of success in the proud history of South Dakota basketball. In one of the nation's best conferences, Boots's teams compiled a 216-114 (.655) record - the best mark of any league member in that time. The Coyotes never finished lower than fifth in the NCC during Boots' tenure. Besides the six titles, Boots had four runner-up finishes (1991-92, 1995-96, 1996-97, 2004-05) to his credit.

Boots is a 1979 graduate of Augsburg and earned his master's degree from the University of Minnesota in 1982. As a senior at Augsburg during the 1978-79 campaign, Boots was named team captain, the team's most valuable player, All-MIAC and All-District 13. He is still the holder of the MIAC single-season free-throw percentage record (.971) and Augsburg's career free-throw percentage mark (.881).

The first thing South Dakota men's basketball fans will notice about their team's 2012-13 roster is that the Coyotes are a brand new team. Gone are four of five starters from a 10-18 squad. In their place step a former Kansas State guard in senior Juevol Myles, two junior-college transfers and three freshmen, all of whom USD fans will get to know well in the months to come.

The constant of the program remains its coaching staff headed by Dave Boots, the leader of the pack now for a quarter century. Boots has nearly 500 wins at USD and enjoyed 23 consecutive winning seasons before receiving a rude welcome by The Summit League and its constituents. A crafty veteran, Boots is making his adjustments.

"This roster has a little bit more than it did a year ago," said Boots. "Our team is deeper and more athletic and that's the direction we are trying to move in terms of recruiting. We have become a fully-eligible Division I program and it is expected that we add to our roster talent wise to be competitive.

"Our talent has improved. It is still not game ready or battle-tested because our team hasn't been through it. That is the next stage in this process."

That stage started in late August when the team crossed the Canadian border and won two games in Winnipeg. Myles averaged 24 points in the series. Boots got a jump on molding his new team.

"Canada was a great trip for us," said Boots. "We were able to have 10 practices before that and it really accelerated our process by being able to teach our system. It will put us ahead of where we normally would be if we did not have that trip."

That's a good thing considering the schedule Boots has put in place. The Coyotes begin with four games in five days, including three at a tournament in Wyoming before traveling to NCAA-qualifier Gonzaga in Washington.

It doesn't get any easier.

The non-conference slate also includes a trip to Iowa City to take on the Hawkeyes of the Big Ten (Dec. 4) and a New Year's Eve party at Bramlage Coliseum where the Coyotes will meet the Big 12's Kansas State Wildcats. Both competed in postseason tournaments a year ago.

An away-and-home series with a 19-win Ball State program, a home contest with an 18-win Morehead State program (Dec. 19) and a Dec. 22 trip to Green Bay (15-15) will test the Coyotes before the break.

Boots pieced this schedule together with the big picture in mind. He wants this team to be ready for Summit League play and, with all but two players set to return a year from now, he's preparing this squad for future success.

"Our team has arrived from different systems, whether it is high school or junior college, and they are going to have to adjust to our system quickly," said Boots. "Do we get off to a slow start because of it? Possibly. But the goal is that by January or February everyone is acclimated to our program and we can start being a real quality basketball team."

Summit League play crescendos into March and peaks at the conference tournament, this year held March 9-12 in Sioux Falls, where three wins earn you a ticket to the NCAA tournament. With conference newcomer Omaha ineligible for postseason play, the league's remaining eight teams are assured an invitation to Sioux Falls.

"The goal is always to be playing your best at the end of the year," said Boots. "Last year, we were best in our last month at home. This year, we will be on the road at the end of the regular season. If we can win some of those games, we will be ready for the tournament where anything can happen in a few days' time."

### Let's meet the team

South Dakota's roster lists 15 names, but two – Trey Norris (North Texas) and Adam Thoseby (Utah State) – will sit a year after moving to Vermillion. That leaves an available roster of 13.

The six returners from a year ago include two of the team's three co-captains in junior center Trevor Gruis and the coach's son, senior guard Jordan Boots (Myles is the third co-captain). Junior guard Steve Tecker started 10 games a year ago. Junior center Jared Bartling (21 GP, 1 start) and sophomores Brandon Bos (22 GP, 2 starts) and Jack Foley (1 GP) also return.

The six newcomers include junior college transfers Tyler Larson (Casper College) and Karim Rowson (Western Oklahoma

State) along with freshmen Casey Kasperbauer (Carroll, Iowa), Tyler Flack (Lakeville, Minn.) and Eric Robertson (Wayzata, Minn.). Tucker Volesky (Mitchell, S.D.) is a walk on.

Classify Myles as you wish.

“Trevor, Jordan and Steve have the most experience from last year,” said Boots.

“Brandon got some experience and Jared played in some games as well. It helped that Juevol spent his year practicing with us so he should be ready to go and he is a quality player. That looks to be our core group of returners.

“Moving on to the new guys, the three freshmen have done a nice job and all are going to play. We think they can help in significant ways. Tyler (Larson) and Karim are athletic, they have some toughness to them and they have good skills. This is the team that is going to try to improve on a year ago.”

A closer look at the roster and you will notice only four players labeled either “C” or “F”. Don’t fret. Boots prides himself on teaching athletes how to excel at multiple positions.

“We are not very conventional when we say you’re a forward, you’re a center, you’re a guard,” said Boots. “We try to move our athletes all around.

“Our guards are interchangeable. Trevor is our five man but he is very comfortable playing around the perimeter. Larson can play three different positions. Steve can play the two, three or four. Tyler Flack is a versatile player who can do that as well.”

The frontcourt will revolve around Gruis, Bartling, Flack and Robertson. Gruis averaged 11 points while serving as the team’s leading rebounder a season ago. Flack averaged 13 points as a senior at Lakeville North High School. Robertson was a Mr. Basketball semifinalist in the state of Minnesota after averaging 20 points and nine rebounds at Wayzata High School.

“Tyler (Flack) is one of the best athletic big kids we have brought into our program,” said Boots. “He is a little raw in a few areas, but he has the ability to score, block shots and rebound.

“Eric is a well-rounded player who is talented both offensively and defensively. He can contribute right away and we like his ability.”

The backcourt will be headed by Myles who can play both point and off guard. Myles averaged 12 points as a freshman at Tallahassee Community College before spending his sophomore season at Kansas State where he appeared in 19 games.

“Juevol is a competitor who wants to win,” said Boots. “He shoots well, has a nice pull-up jumper and can get to the basket. He has great strength. He’s been a terrific leader for a player who has only been with our program for one year.”

Jordan Boots has been a 34-percent three-point shooter in three seasons for the Coyotes and has made 98 treys in 93 games. He has also handed out more than 100 assists at USD. Kasperbauer, a four-time, all-state honoree for Carroll High School, averaged 24 points per game as a senior, including a 47-point performance against Winterset.

“We need Jordan to shoot it with more consistency and we need Casey to be a consistent scorer as well,” said Boots. “We are not a team that is going to knock down 12-13 threes a game, but we need Jordan and Casey to provide a threat on the perimeter.”

Larson and Rowson are expected to play a variety of positions. Larson scored 14 points in both games played in Canada and averaged 12 points last season at Casper College. Rowson was Western Oklahoma State’s leading scorer a year ago at 18 points per game. He poured in 40 points in a contest against Seminole State.

“We are going to ask both Tyler (Larson) and Karim to play a lot for us,” said Boots. “They are both good defenders and good rebounders. Once they adjust to our system – and they are well on their way – they are going to be great contributors.”

### Final thoughts

A new team won’t change Boots’ defensive philosophy. His teams typically offer matchup zones with man-to-man principles. He expects an aggressive defense that provides high energy and has placed an added emphasis on defensive rebounding.

“We haven’t taken a big enough step forward in that area as of yet,” said Boots. “Our new athleticism might help us from that standpoint.”

Offensively, Boots would prefer to get away from the top-heavy scoring that last year’s team featured when two players averaged 18 and 16 points per game while nearly everyone else averaged less than six.

“A well-balanced offense has always been a trademark of our success,” said Boots. “We need to get back to that and not just with our starters, but with the players who come off the bench. That was a serious weakness a year ago. We need to have 5-7 players on a given night – if they all play well – score in double figures.

“The road we are heading down is important. We have a good core that can get it done on the court and in the classroom. It takes time to get to the top and it has to be done the right way. We will make some strides this year, get more games under our belt and continue to progress towards a bright future.”

## Coyotes in the Postseason

### USD Captures '58 National Title; 19-13 in NCAA Tournament

In a long and storied history, The South Dakota men's basketball team has been a consistent player on the national level. During its run in NCAA Division II, the Coyotes compiled a 19-13 overall record in the national playoffs. In 11 trips to national tournament play, the Coyotes failed to win a game just three times (1999-00, lost to Wayne State, 86-83; 2005-06, lost to Winona State, 81-69, in overtime; and 2007-08, lost to Northern State, 70-69). USD put together a 16-9 record in regional tournament games (including district play) while going 3-4 at national tourney games.

Led by George DeKlotz, the Coyotes made their initial appearance in the national playoffs during the 1949-50 season. Playing in the National Association of Intercollegiate Basketball District 12 tournament, South Dakota defeated Huron (69-54) and North Dakota (64-61 in overtime) to advance to the NAIB National Tournament in Kansas City, Mo. At the national tourney, USD fell to East Texas State (now Texas A&M-Commerce), 55-51.

In 1956-57, USD began the first of two consecutive trips to the NCAA national collegiate tournament. After advancing through regional play, the Coyotes fell to the eventual national champion Wheaton (Ill.), 90-80.

In 1957-58, South Dakota won its first national title. Led by head coach Dwane Clodfelter, the Coyotes won three games with margins of victory of four points or less. In regional play, the Coyotes edged Wartburg, 67-65, before downing Knox, 102-52. Then, at the national tournament in Evansville, Ind., South Dakota defeated Southwest Missouri State and avenged a loss to Wheaton (Ill.) in the final regular season game. USD defeated SE Missouri State, 63-58, and Wheaton, 64-60. In its first ever national title game, the Coyotes rolled to a 75-53 win over St. Michael's (Vermont). Jim Daniels led USD to the win by scoring 40 points and earning selection to the all tournament squad. That season, Daniels was also named to the small college All-American team. Clodfelter's Coyotes had a marvelous run to the title. The U opened 2-5 with losses to Wisconsin (63-56), Missouri (73-62), Regis (74-64), Purdue (74-62) and Northwestern (64-46). After the loss to Northwestern, USD won 20 straight games to claim the school's first national crown. In that special season, the Coyotes finished 12-0 as they became the first school in the history of the North Central Conference to complete a 12-game league schedule unbeaten.

Led by head coach Bob Mulcahy, USD earned a third place finish at the NCAA regional tournament in 1971-72. The U also finished third at the DII regional in 1989-90, led by coach Dave Boots. In the 1992-93 season, USD put together a 25-5 record and advanced to the NCAA Division II

Elite Eight Championships. In the first round of that national tournament, USD lost a heartbreaking 100-96 (3OT) game to New Hampshire at Springfield, Mass. In that game, USD received a career-high 28 points and 11 rebounds from junior Shane Murphy.

With seniors Randy Rosenquist, Chris Jones, Murphy and Troy Terronez leading the way, the Coyotes again advanced to the NCAA Division II Elite Eight Championships in 1993-94. USD hosted the regional and defeated North Dakota (94-76) and North Dakota State (61-58) at the DakotaDome. In the Elite Eight, the Coyotes lost to eventual national runners-up Southern Indiana (98-77).

In the past 14 years, USD has made seven regional appearances. In those trips to the national tournament, the Coyotes have only lost in the first round three times (2000, 2006, 2008).

In the 2004-05 regional tournament played at the Auraria Events Center in Denver, Colo., USD defeated Nebraska-Kearney in the first round, 94-84, avenging its loss to the Lopers in the 2003-04 regional tournament (86-80). In the second round, the Coyotes handled Winona State, 73-68. Then, in the regional final, South Dakota dropped a hard fought battle to Metro State, 89-84. Guard Josh Mueller scored 30 points.

In the 2005-06 regionals, the eighth-seeded Coyotes gave the top-seeded and eventual national champion Winona State Warriors all they could handle. USD led Winona State 34-32 at halftime, and 60-56 with 1:14 left in regulation. However, WSU battled back and forced the game into overtime, where they won by a final margin of 81-69.

USD made its fourth straight appearance in the national tournament in 2006-07. Despite receiving 18 points from Tyler Cain and Dylan Grimsley, USD fell in the first round to Nebraska-Kearney. South Dakota had five players score in double-figures in the game. Cain had an impressive debut in the NCAA Tournament. Along with his 18 points, he also grabbed 13 rebounds, blocked four shots and dished out three assists.

In their final season at Division II, Boots' Coyotes earned a fifth straight national tournament berth, setting a school record. The Coyotes dropped a 70-69 decision to Northern State. In the game, USD rallied from a 14-point second half deficit to take a lead in the final minute. NSU made two free throws to grab a lead with 10 seconds to play.

Led by all-time leading shot blocker Tyler Cain, USD earned its first postseason berth at the Division I level with a 91-86 win over Houston Baptist in the 2010 Great West Conference Championship title game. The Coyotes advanced to the CollegenInsider.com Postseason Tournament where they lost at Creighton.
