Strangways Hall is situated in the Market Square opposite the Ilchester Arms Hotel in the centre of Abbotsbury, which is one of the picturesque villages on the B3157 Coastal Heritage Route, between Weymouth and Bridport.

As the old village school, this is a handsome and substantial Grade 2 Listed Building. It comprises 2 halls, a kitchen, toilets and a playground, which are hired out as a complete package. Due to the layout of the building it is hired out as a whole.

There is full access for the disabled and hard of hearing, and wheelchair access to the whole site.

Each hall can accommodate up to 65 people.

The kitchen is equipped with 2 cookers, a fridge, microwave and crockery and cutlery for 65 persons.

Chairs and folding tables are provided. The tables and some stacking chairs can be hired separately.

Parking is available in the village car park, and there is a bus stop right outside the Hall.



Abbotsbury is a popular place for tourists. The village boasts its own shops, galleries, pubs and tearooms and three internationally known attractions, the Swannery, the Tithe Barn and the award winning Sub-Tropical Gardens. Walkers also like to access the Coastal Path from the lane leading to St Catherine's Chapel, which is well worth a visit, with its beautiful views of the Chesil Beach. The Chapel is sometimes used for weddings or private blessings, so the Strangways Village Hall can serve as an ideal place to use for the reception, party or banquet.



Some uses for the HALL

During school term time the hall can be hired for afternoons and evenings, or for all day at weekends. The Hall is popular with many artists and exhibitors hiring it to display their work and run workshops. It also makes a great venue for parties, rehearsals, meetings, fairs and sales.

During school holidays Abbotsbury is a thriving tourist destination, and this makes exhibitions in the Hall very successful.
