Profile

Currently the Chairman and Director of Interventional Cardiology at Metro group of hospitals, Dr. Purshottam Lal, a pioneer in Interventional Cardiology, has the **unique distinction of introducing the largest number of interventional techniques** (as an alternative to open heart surgery) for the first time in the country. He is **credited with performing the largest number of angioplasties/stentings procedures as a single operator in the country**. After spending 15 years in the United States, Dr. Lal decided to come back to India and has since established 9 state-of-the-art hospitals with a mission to serve the poor. **His guiding philosophy in setting up these hospitals has been that no patient should ever be returned for want of money**.

Dr. Lal is also passionate about teaching and has taught over a period of 20 years a large number of medical students, residents and fellows in the field of Interventional cardiology. His students are spread far and wide and count among them some illustrious names in the field of Cardiology.

An internationally acclaimed Interventional Cardiologist, Dr. Lal is by far the most decorated Interventional Cardiologist of the Country for having been awarded Padma Bhushan, Padma Vibhushan and Dr. B.C. Roy National Award of Medical Council of India by the President of India for his innovative contributions in the field of Interventional Cardiology. Academics

Post-graduate Training & Teaching experience (more than 20 years):

Having been trained at internationally renowned institutions in the United States, UK and Germany, Dr. Lal is deeply interested in passing on knowledge and imparting skills to an ever increasing number of budding cardiologists. This is amply reflected in the choices he has made throughout his long career.

- Immediately after graduating from Government Medical College, Amritsar, Dr. Lal joined Government Medical College, Patiala in 1976 as a **demonstrator in the Department of Anatomy** and taught medical students about human anatomy.
- In the same year he left for United States. After completing his post graduate training and passing the American Specialty Board, he joined as Instructor followed by Assistant Clinical Professor at Mich. University in 1983 where he taught medical students as well as post-graduate students (residents). He was instructor of Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certified by American Heart Association and maintained Physician Recognition Award by American Medical Association for continuing medical education. He also held the positions of Registrar in the Dept. of Cardiology and Visiting Consultant in UK & Germany respectively where he was involved in the pacemakers & advanced structural interventional cardiology.
- While working as a **Senior Interventional Cardiologist** at Apollo Hospitals, Madras in 1991 he was involved in the teaching of **DNB Cardiology students**.
- Dr. Lal was appointed as **Attending Cardiologist** at Cornell Medical Centre USA in 1994 and was assigned teaching and research related responsibilities.
- He has worked as **Senior Interventional Cardiologist & Coordinator, Department of Cardiology** at Indraprastha Apollo Hospitals, New Delhi in 1996 where he taught **Interventional Cardiology fellows**.
- From 1997 onwards Dr. Lal has been involved in teaching and training activities as **Director Interventional Cardiology** at Metro Heart Institute, NOIDA. He has been involved in the teaching of **DNB students** and students pursuing Postgraduate Diploma Courses in Cardiology (**PGDCC**) at the institute.

Research & Professional Achievements:

Dr. Purshotam Lal is credited with introducing the largest number of procedures in the field of Interventional cardiology in the country (more than twenty 'firsts'). Among these:

- Slow Rotational angioplasty (Rotacs)
- Coronary Athrectomy
- Rotablator (diamond drilling)
- T Stenting
- Heart hole closure (ASD)
- Post myocardial VSD Closure
- Repair of Abdominal Aneurysmand many more

He subsequently presented the **first ever scientific papers on these techniques** at the annual conferences of the Cardiological Society of India. These were later on published in the Indian Heart Journal.

- He has developed his own techniques of left atriofemoral bypass support (partial artificial heart) & opening of tight heart valves (with echo without cath lab) and presented the papers in national & international conferences to this effect.
- Dr. Lal is credited with his contributions in the clinical development of monodisc device for ASD Closure and Core Valve for non-surgical replacement of aortic valve. He performed the first case of non-surgical heart hole (ASD Closure) on a 19 year college student, this being the first case in the medical literature with this particular device. He also performed the non-surgical aortic valve replacement with a core valve on a 69 year old terminal patient unfit for surgery. This case being the first in the world and more than 20000 cases have been performed successfully around the world with this technique. All this work have been presented and published in the national & international journals.
- He is the **first investigator of Inoue Balloon Mitral Valvuloplasty** in the Country, the most popular balloon in the world for opening the tight valves of the heart and compared the same with the other available techniques.
- He has also performed more than 25 life saving procedures of **non surgical** closure of Post MI VSD, one of the largest series in the medical literature.
- He designed the concept of 'Metro Coronary Screening' for the detection of early coronary artery disease in the high risk individuals. It involves echocardiography, blood tests and coronary angiography through left arm

which has been made patient friendly taking less than five minutes and the individual can return to work within one hour. Dr. Lal has himself performed more than 13000 such procedures (the largest series in the medical literature) since its introduction in 1998 with 100% success.

- Dr. Lal has been performing the largest number of angioplasties/stentings as a single operator over a period of 10 years and has been honoured with "Distinguished Achievement Award of Highest Order" by the National Forum of Indian Medical Association (2006-07) for performing the largest number of angioplasties/stentings as a single operator in the Country.
- His name has been listed several times in the Limca Book of World Records.
- He has published over one hundred research papers, articles and chapters and has also authored a book "Cause and Prevention of Heart Diseases". In some of the conferences he presented record number of papers namely:-
