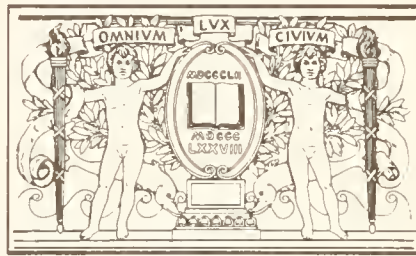

P.D. 43 - ELECTION STATISTICS FOR 1983

This booklet contains information about local elections and special state elections held in 1983. It lists the dates for the city and town elections, the number of people registered to vote in each precinct of each community, and the number of people who voted in the local election. It does not include any candidate information. Each city and town maintains its own record of local candidates and their vote totals.

In odd-numbered years like 1983, Election Statistics also provides detailed results of special state elections which were held to fill vacancies. This year there were six of these elections.

This 1983 booklet also includes a list of mayors and their terms and city managers of the cities, and a list of the kinds of local elections held by each city and town in the Commonwealth. It does not include lists of city and town clerks and election commissioners and of selectmen, but these are available from the Elections Division. Names of other local officials are available from the local clerks.

P.D. 43 in even-numbered years is a larger volume, which gives the results of state primaries and elections for all candidates and questions on the ballot as well as information on local elections.
