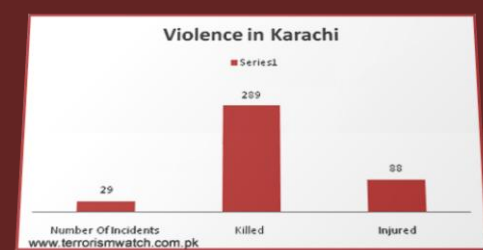
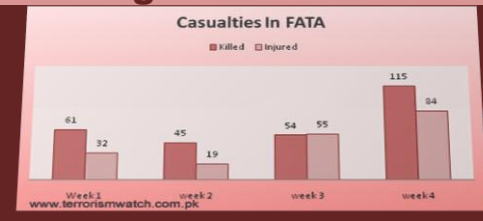
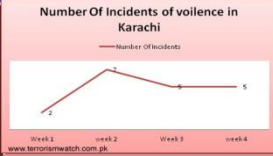
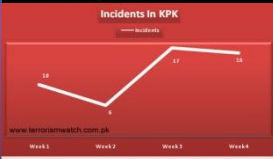
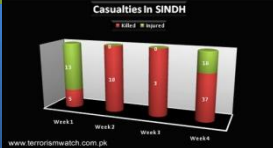


# Pakistan Security Analysis Annual Report 2011

## Over view

The Annual Report of CIRCLe covers all the aspects of terrorism in Pakistan. The ice which broke in 2001 is still in lengths and widths of Pakistan not a single province is peaceful. Terrorists have showed their power when ever and whenever they wanted. In 2010 situations were worst if compared to 2011 in 2010. 89 drone attacks happened in Pakistan killing 890 people. Many times civilians and security forces were killed in drones as well. The total of 890 includes militants, civilians and security forces as well. NATO force did 76 drone attacks in 2011 killing 509 people. Other than that in the last month of 2011 no drone attack was reported. After Salala Check post incident Pakistan stopped NATO Containers movement in its territory. NATO force apologized for their act but still no by road transportation is allowed to NATO force. In 2010 Target killing was not as strong as it was in 2011 .When in 2011 drone attacks and Suicide attacks were reported less. Target killing became the new threat. Only in August 2011 97 Cases of target killing were reported and 324 people lost their lives Karachi had been a battle field for

extremists and armed wings of political parties. Secretarial killing and target killing was a common practice in Karachi and Balochistan as well.

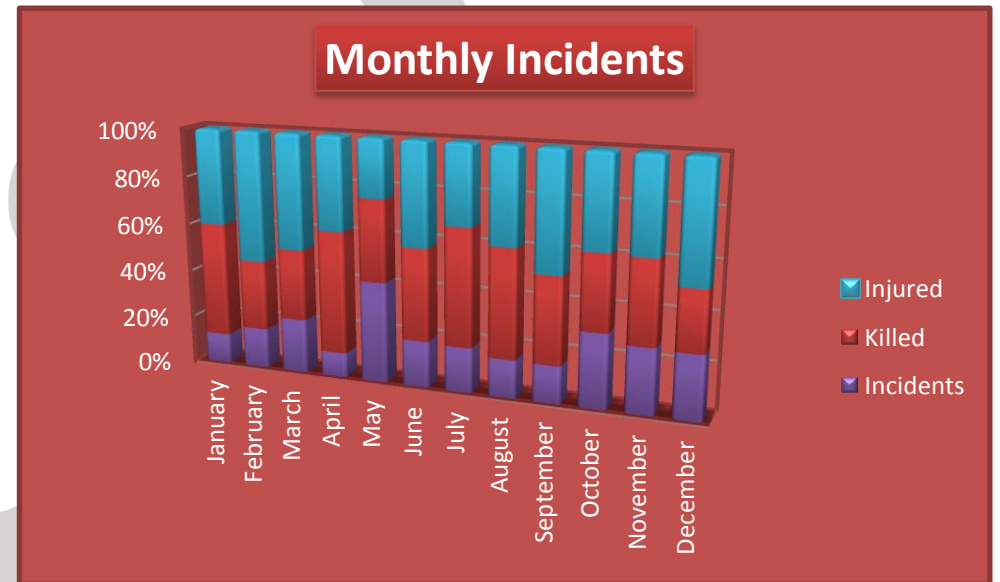
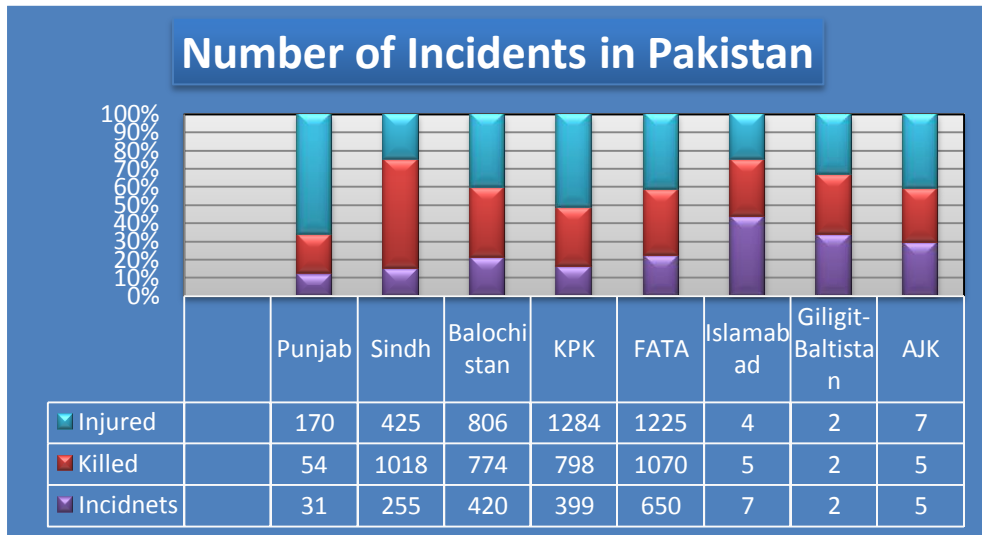
2011 will always be remembered because of Osama Bin Laden. The reign of Osama Bin Laden finally ended in May 2011. After these incidents the Pak USA relations suffered many ups and downs. Now After 11 years of war on terror the terror has become more strong and resistant. When Security Forces conduct operations against militants, for the time being the terrorism activities are slowed down but after some time they come up with more force and resistance. The banned Organizations who are engaged in all those religious activities at the name of religion and Islam don't care about any religions and sacred place. They don't fear bombing on mosque they don't care attacking shrines, in 2010, 10 shrines were attacked and 5 shrines were attacked in 2011. Almost 209 people were killed and 560 injured since there blasts and attacks at shrine and religions place have started. Discussion will pro long if each part of terrorism war is highlighted, CIRCLe in all its abilities tried to make a comprehensive and informative report. Lets all hope that 2012 may be better then past.

**Number of Incidents in Pakistan**

2011 ended with a chapter of terror and extremism. This year lots of operations were conducted against terrorists all over Pakistan. The killing of Osama Bin Laden and then Raymond Davis case also remained hot news this year. Sindh, Balochistan, FATA and KPK were most of the disturbed regions of Pakistan. Punjab, AJK and Gilgit Baltistan were relatively peaceful as compared to rest of PAKISTAN. 2011 was a tragic year. A number of political and religious figures were targeted and killed. Salman Taseer was shot dead by his own gunman due to a religious issue. Karachi was flooded by target killings and a big number of citizens lost their lives. 965 people were killed in Karachi in target killing.

**Monthly Incidents**

1714 different incidents happened this year of terrorism and violence all over Pakistan. It includes target killing, suicide attacks, operations and other incidents of extremism. Around 3565 people were killed and 3651 were injured in 2011. July was at top of the list with 183 reported incidents.

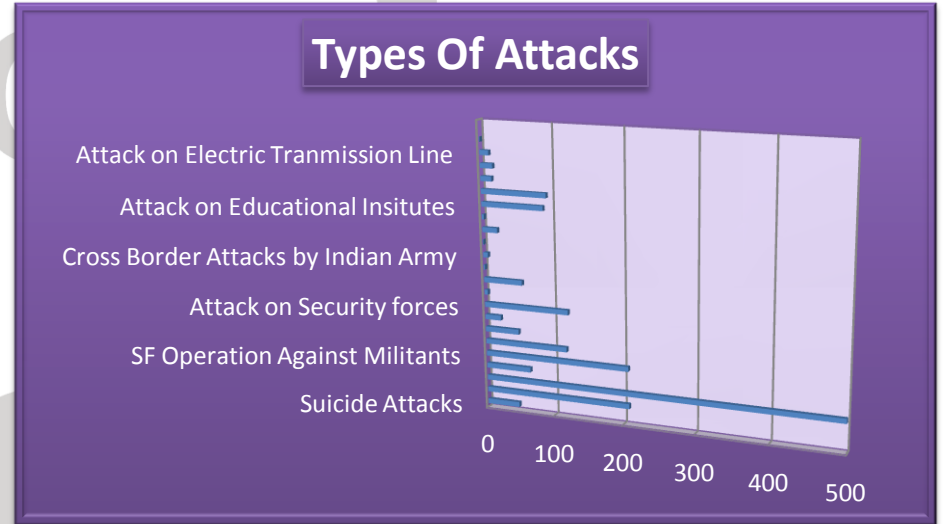
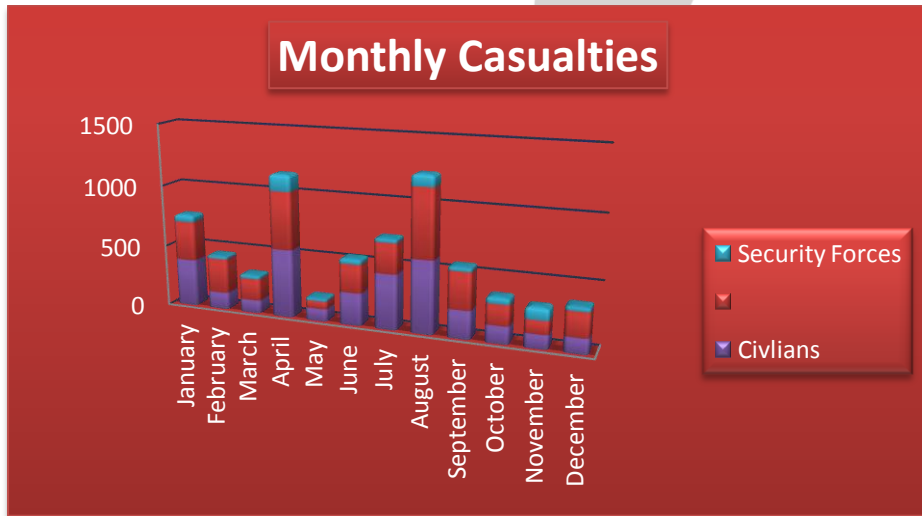


**Monthly Casualties**

This year the number of total casualties including civilians, security forces and militants was 6561. August was top of the list with over 586 civilians killed. Most of them were gunned down in KARACHI in target killings. Karachi which is said to be industrial hub of PAKISTAN was in wave of fear and terror this year. 3182 civilians lost their lives while 3111 suffered injuries. 637 security men were killed and 888 were injured. Almost 2742 militants were killed and 591 were injured in different operations. In last two months of 2011, security forces conducted several operations against militant's. Most of them were successful and militants suffered heavy loss.

**Types of Attacks**

This year 22 different kinds of incidents were reported. The total number of all incidents was 1666. Major incidents were target killings, security forces operations, and hand grenade and rockets attacks. In 2011, less suicide attacks and drone attacks were reported if compared to past years. Target killing was top of the list with 499 incidents. Sectarian violence and target killings increased in 2011. In SINDH and Balochistan a large number of people including religious, political and social figures were targeted.

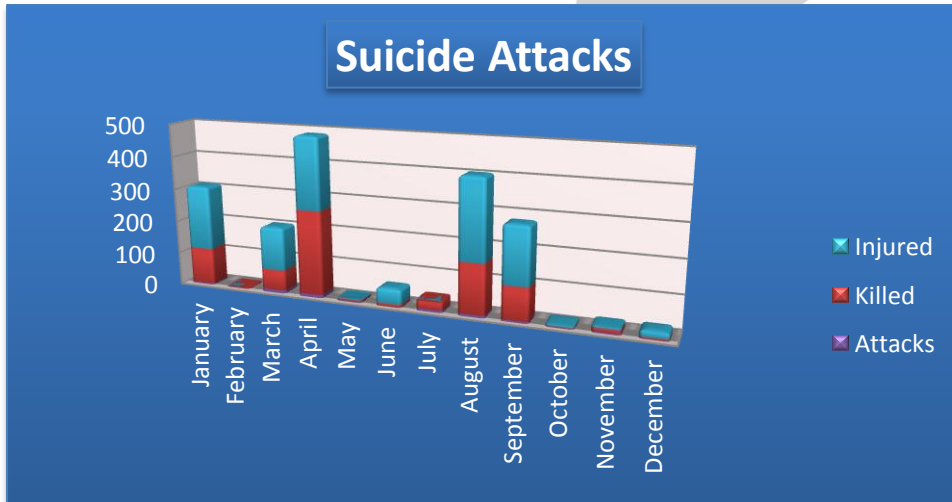

### Suicide Attacks

This year was relatively peaceful if compared to 2010. 51 cases of suicide attacks were reported this year. 739 people were killed and 1042 were injured. Taliban's and Government was negotiating and having few peace talks in this regard though both deny it but people of Pakistan had little relief with less amount of attacks.



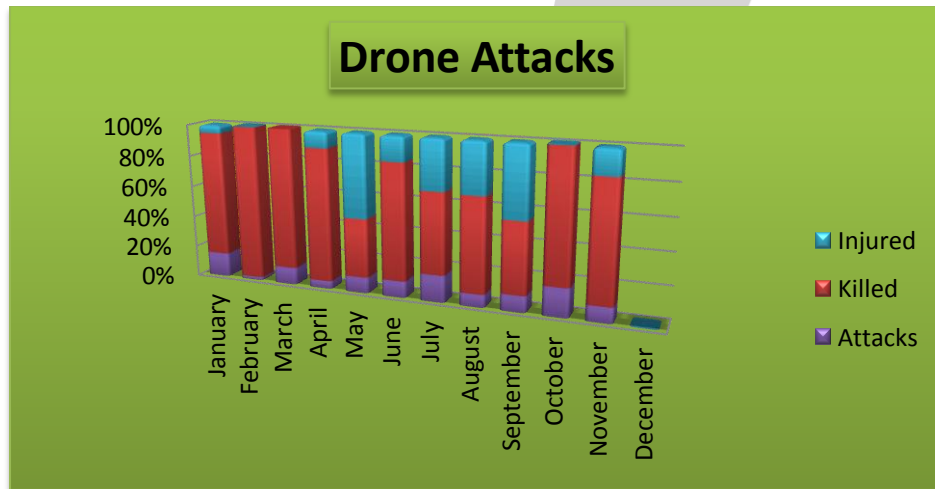

Total 64 drone attacks happened. In 2011 killing 490 people mostly militants and injuring 109 others.

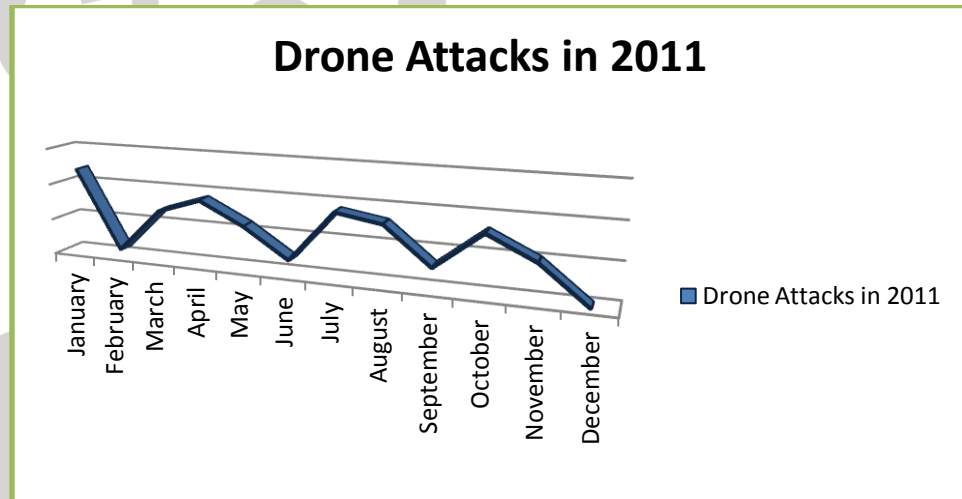
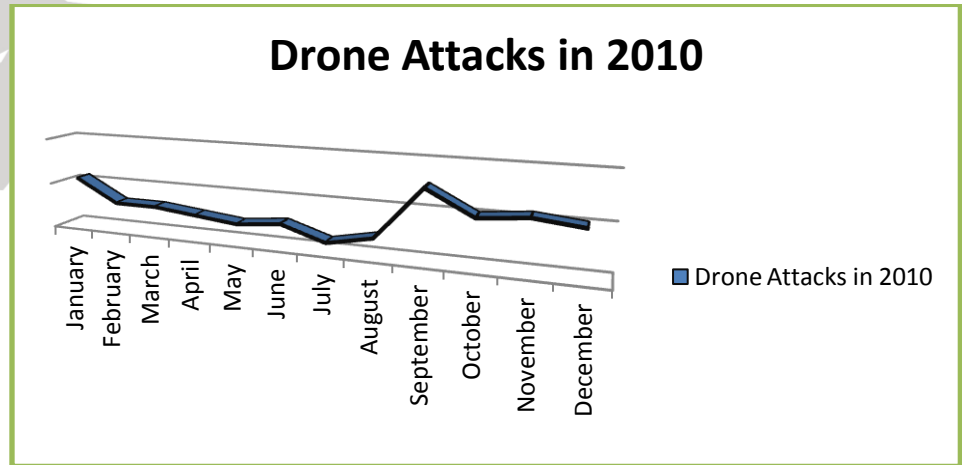

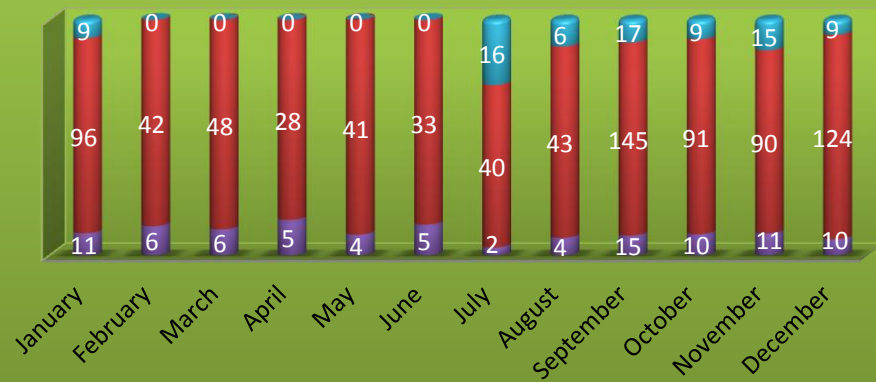
**Comparison of Drone Attacks in 2010, 2011**

Drones are such threat to Pakistan s peace and sovereignty that is always endangered. No one knows how when and where a Drone will attack and kill many People. Though these CIA operated drones are meant to target Militants but many Civilians and Pakistan Army men have lost their lives. In 2010 89 drone attacks were reported claiming 821 lives and 89 were reported injured .Many Civilians and Security forces Personals also died in these attacks. More over Pakistan Government kept quiet and did not take any strong steps to stop these attacks except condemning. However in 2011 situation was not as bad as in 2010.70 drone attacks were reported killing 457 lives and 122 persons sustained injuries. December 2011 was a golden month in which no drone attack was reported. After Salala check post incident in which NATO forces attacked at a Pakistani Military Check post and killed many men, Pakistan took a bold step and stopped movement of NATO containers in its territory. Pak USA relations were on stake these days. After that no drone attack was reported neither any NATO attack took place. This is a serious issue of Pakistan’s security and it should be addressed properly.



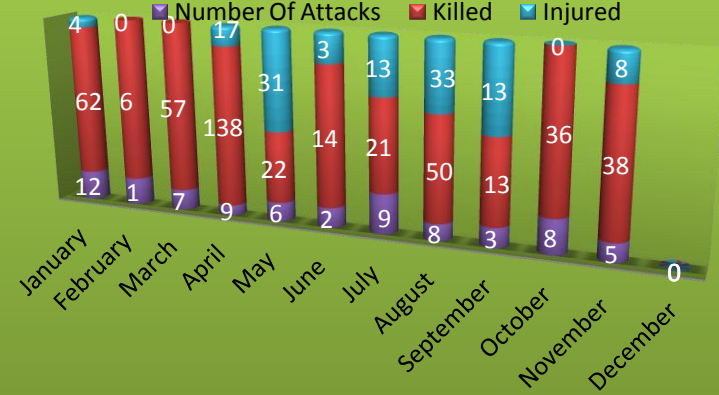
### Drone Attacks In 2010

### Drone Attacks In 2011

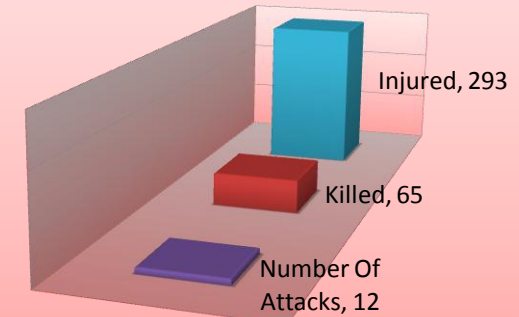
Number Of Attacks Killed Injured



### Attacks on Shrines

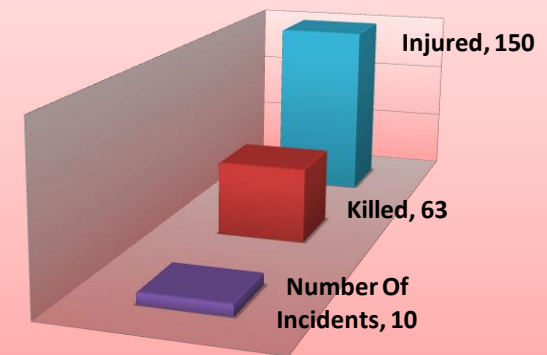

These terrorist who are so called Muslims and according to them they are working for Islam have not left these places secured. A countable number of people have lost their lives in these attacks. Islam is not at all about killing people and blowing others with oneself. Mosques, Tombs, even funeral prayers are not safe from these terrorists. They are not even worthy of being called humans .In year 2010 Twelve shrines were attacked all over Pakistan. Killing 65 people and injuring 293 innocent people including many women and small children. Where as in 2011 Ten Shrines were attacked killing 63 and injuring 150 people. Now it's crystal clear to every sensible person that who is against and on side of Islam and Pakistan.

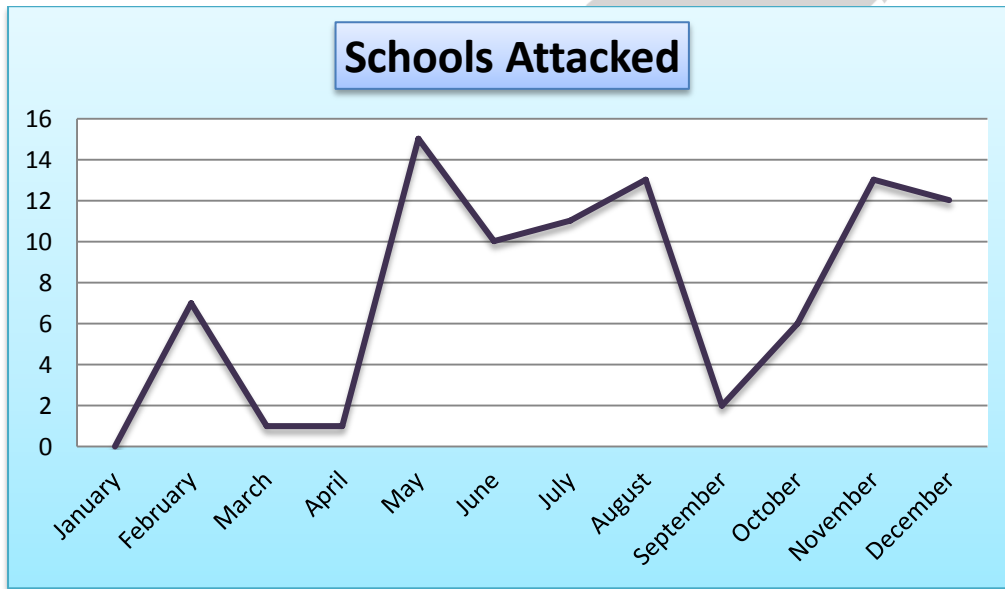

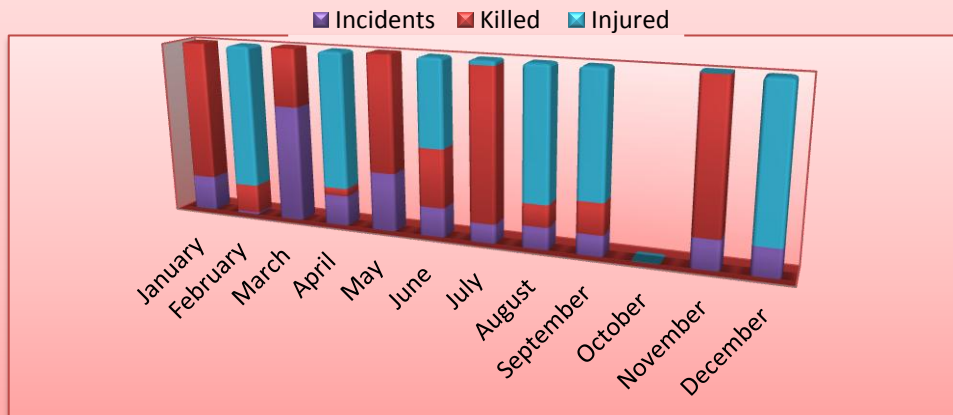
### Punjab

### Overall Incidents in Punjab



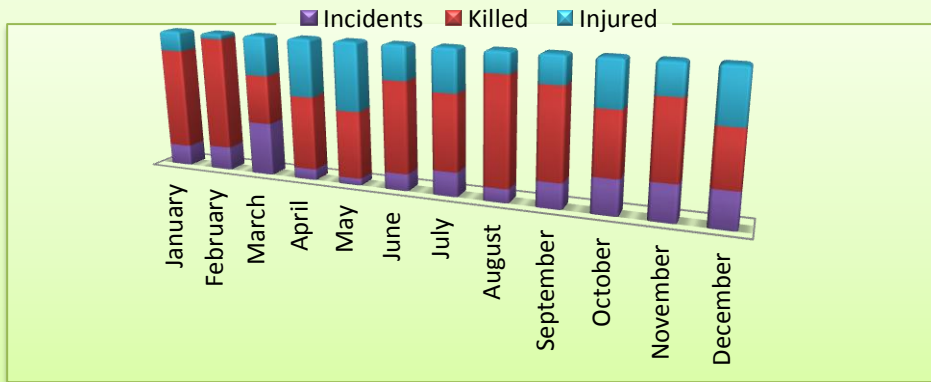
### Sindh

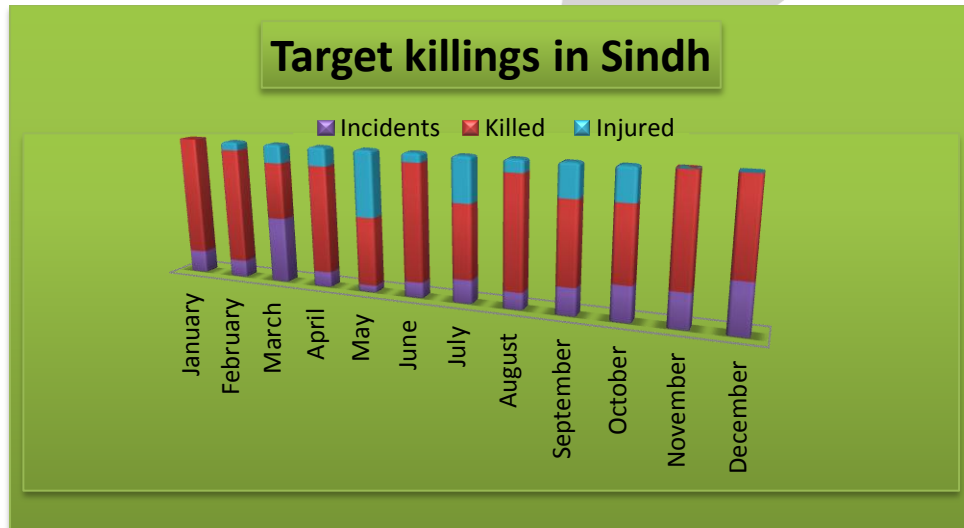

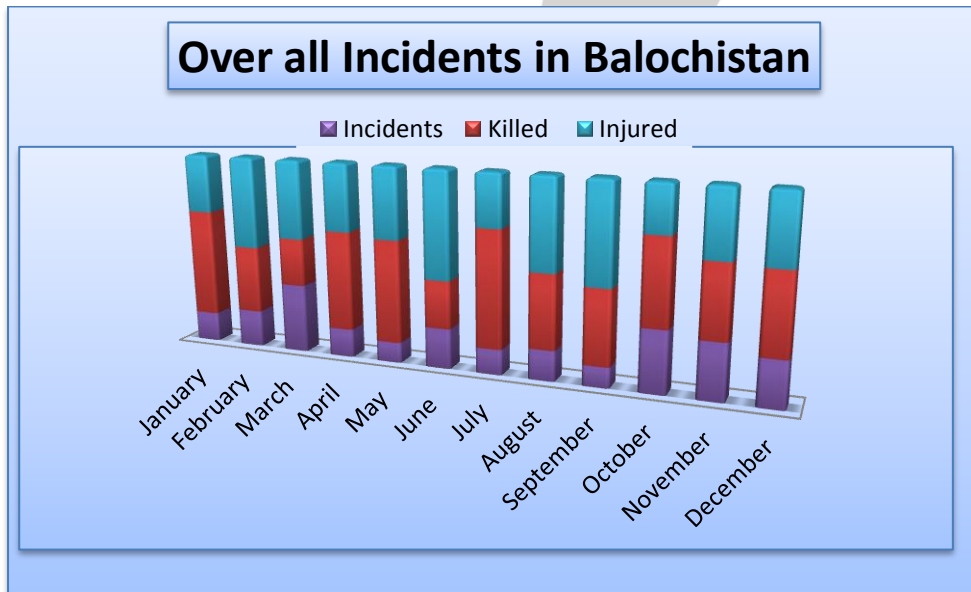

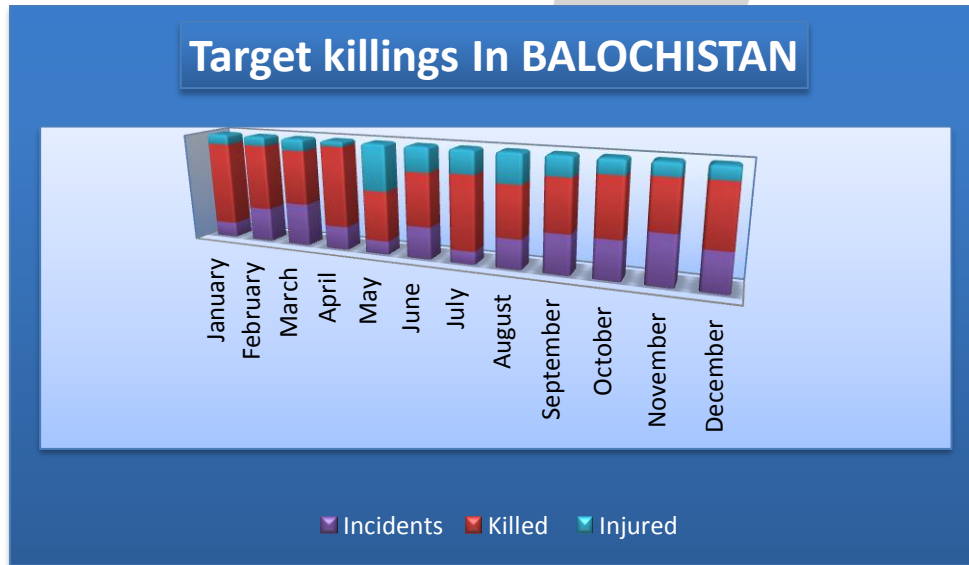


### Target killings in Balochistan

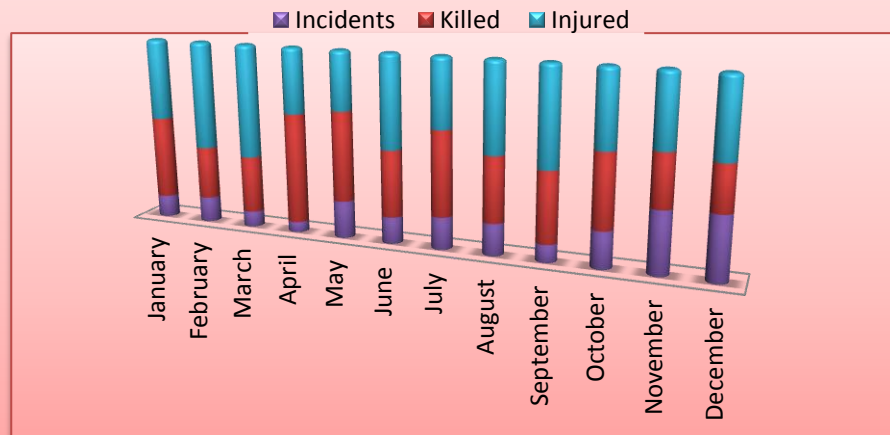
**KPK**

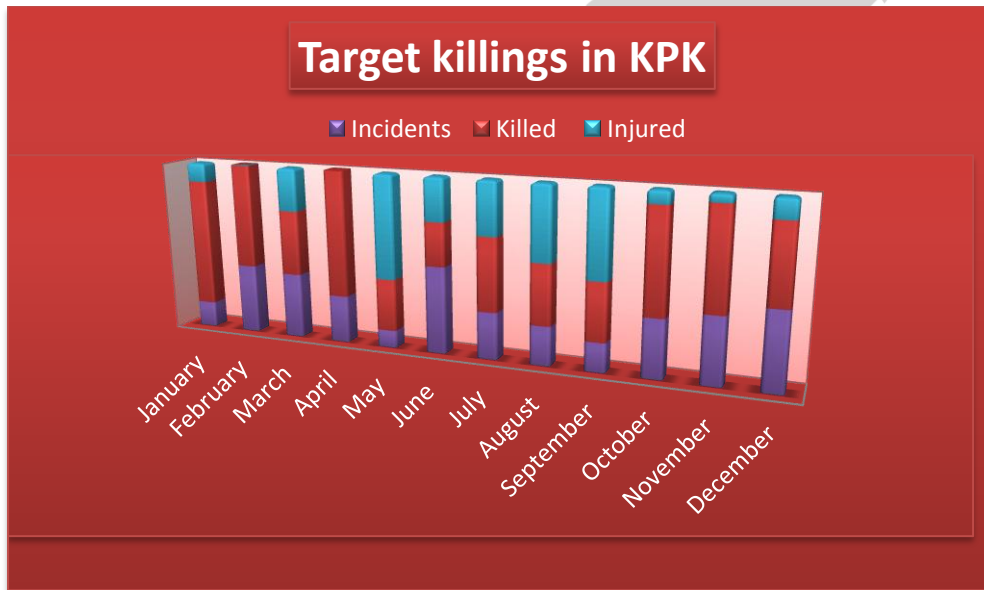

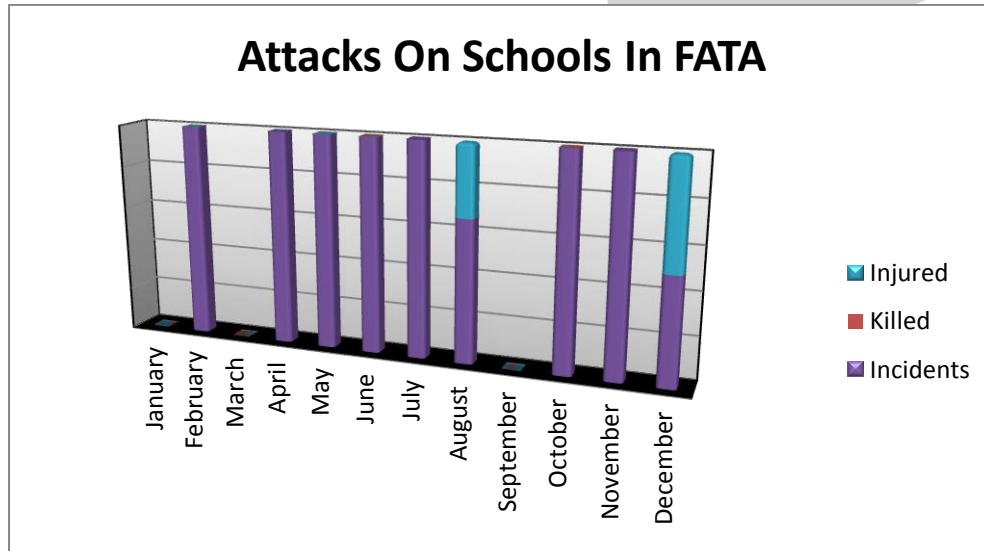

39 cases of attacks on educational institutes were reported this year in FATA injuring 6 persons.



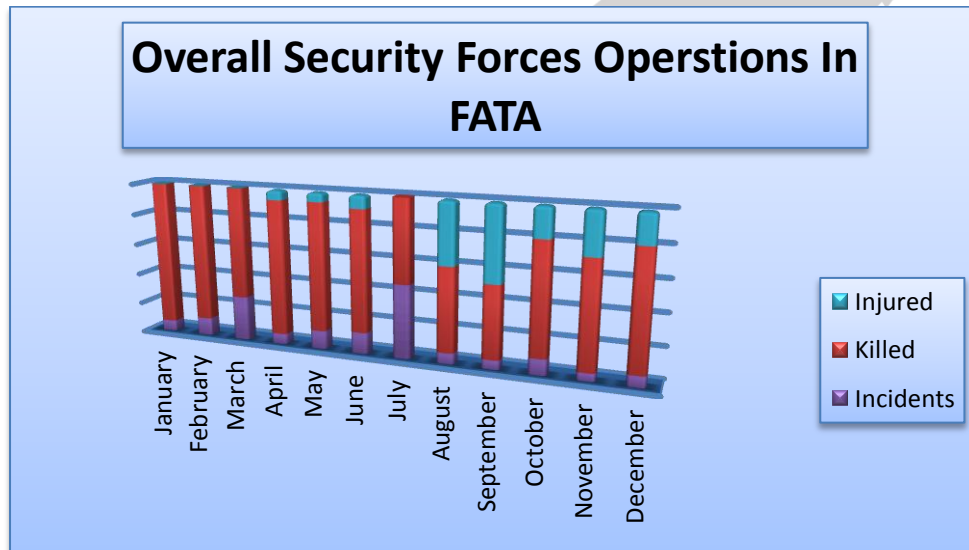

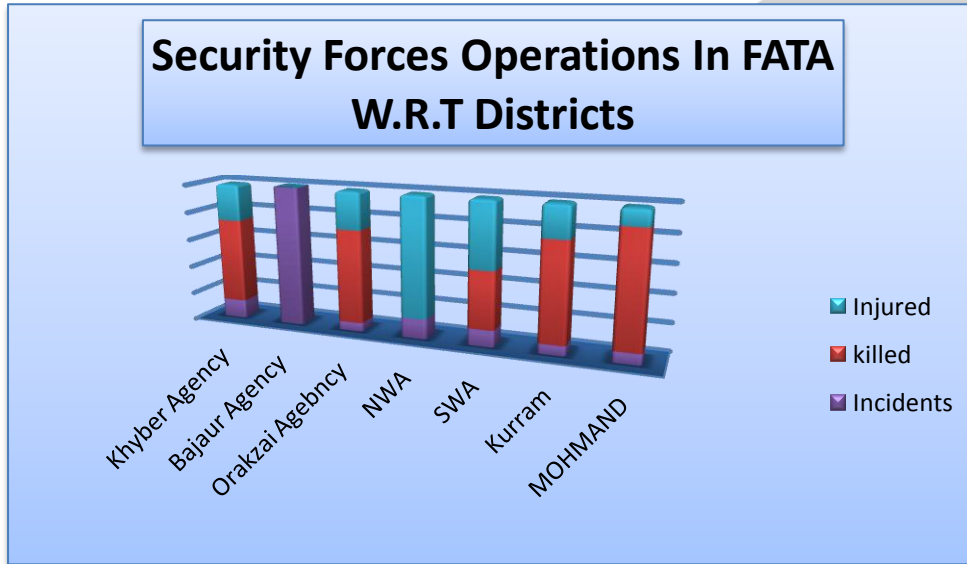
