Long an A.A.U. representative and official, Larry Houston was born at Santa Ana, California on March 18, 1906. An athletic participant at University of California, Los Angeles, Larry was graduated from that institution in 1930.

A dedicated official of the A.A.U., Houston served as President as well as Secretary of the Southern Pacific Association. A member of the U.S.A. Olympic Track & Field Committee, Larry, in admirable manner, carried out the assignment as Asst. Manager of the U.S.A. Olympic Track & Field Team in 1952, and was Manager in 1956.

A wonderful sportsman, Larry Houston has contributed generously of his time and effort in the interest of athletes in all amateur divisions, including high schools and colleges.

This marks the 26th year that Helms Athletic Foundation has issued its Southern California Track and Field Record Book in the interest of high school athletics. It lists outstanding performances and records established by Southland high school track and field performers during the 1962 season. Five hundred record books are distributed by Helms Athletic Foundation each season without charge. Books are sent to coaches at high schools, colleges and universities throughout the country and to press, radio and television commentators, plus athletic coaches and officials.

Material gathered in this booklet has been obtained from sources believed to be reliable. Information has been provided by high school coaches, sports editors of student newspapers, as well as from the sports pages of Southland newspapers.

This 26th annual Track and Field Record Book contains best marks of Los Angeles City and CIF track and field athletes over past years, past City and CIF championship teams and present City, State and National Interscholastic records. The book contains sections on top meets of the year, results of Southern California's five big prep meets of the year, best all-time marks by Southern California prep athletes and many other interesting sections.

Helms Athletic Foundation, with offices at Helms Hall, Los Angeles, is sponsored by Paul H. Helms, Jr. The Foundation was established in 1936, with one of its main functions that of recording the achievements of athletes in all sports and in all divisions.

Track and Field Athletes of the Year are also listed for both Los Angeles City and CIF, selections which have been made by All-Southern California Board of Athletics since 1937.

Track and Field athletes selected for Athlete of the Year honors since 1937, have their names engraved upon the Paul H. Helms perpetual trophy which is permanently lodged in Helms Hall, Los Angeles.

Southern California High School Track & Field Record Books are on file at Helms Hall and available for research purposes.

RICHARD STEBBINS (FREMONT) & FORREST BEATY (GLENDALE HOOVER) WIN TOP '62 TRACK HONORS

A pair of the nation's finest high school sprinters — Forrest Beaty of Hoover High School in Glendale and Richard Stebbins from Los Angeles' Fremont High School — were named Southern California C.I.F. and Los Angeles City Athletes of the Year at the conclusion of the 1962 track and field season. Members of All-Southern California Board of Athletics made the selections at their annual meeting at Helms Hall, early in June.

Fremont High's Richard Stebbins won the 220-yard dash at both the Los Angeles City Championships (21.7) and the State Championships (20.9). His 20.9 sec. clocking at the State Meet at Modesto was his best time of the year at this distance. In the 100-yard dash, Stebbins was a co-winner of the City Meet dash in 9.6 sec., along with Jefferson's Herman Harville. In the State Meet 100, Stebbins placed second behind Forrest Beaty, who won the event in 9.5 sec.

Forrest Beaty, co-athlete of the year winner in 1961 along with Compton's Ullis Williams, was a double winner in the C.I.F. Southern Section Championships, with times of 9.5 in the 100-yard event (which tied a Southern Section record) and 20.4 in the 220. In the State Meet Championships Forrest also ran 9.5 in the 100-yard dash, but was forced to pull up in the 220 due to a muscle spasm.

The names of both Richard Stebbins and Forrest Beaty are engraved upon the Paul H. Helms perpetual trophy which is lodged permanently in Helms Hall. They are also recipients of the Helms Medal award, emblematic of outstanding athletic achievement.

Forrest Beaty was coached at Glendale Hoover High School by Sam Nicholson, while Richard Stebbins coach was Frank Nolbe.
