

2007 SEASON IN REVIEW

The 2007 season was the most successful season in Ohio State soccer history. The Buckeyes won four NCAA tournament games and came within 35 minutes of a national championship Dec. 16 at the College Cup in Cary, N.C.

Ohio State ended its season 17-4-5 overall, setting a school record for wins in a season. After winning the Big Ten Championship over Indiana Nov. 11 in which Ohio State shut out the Hoosiers for a school-record second time in one season, the Buckeyes received their first Top 16 seed in the NCAA Tournament at No. 5. Ohio State then won three consecutive home games, eliminating Louisville 1-0, defending national champion UC Santa Barbara, 4-3, and Bradley, 4-0.

At the College Cup, the Buckeyes shut out Massachusetts 1-0 in the national semifinals before falling to No. 1 Wake Forest, 2-1, after leading 1-0 at halftime. Before 2007, the Buckeyes owned two wins all-time in the NCAA tournament and had never played a game in December. The Buckeyes scored 40 goals during the season (1.5 per game) and allowed 20 (0.8 per game). 10 of those goals were scored in the NCAA tournament games, including back-to-back four-goal outputs for the first time since early 2004.

Ohio State, which led the Big Ten in shots, out-shot 19 of its 26 opponents and led that category overall 428-325 (16.5-12.5 per game). The Buckeyes' shots on goal advantage was 166-121 and their corner kick lead was 158-109.

A SEASON OF FIRSTS

Highlights from the 2007 season included...

- Aug. 31 – Ohio State beats No. 13 West Virginia, 1-0, in the first live game broadcast of the Big Ten Network.
- Sept. 9 – Ohio State beats William & Mary, 5-0, for the Buckeyes' biggest margin of victory since 1999.
- Sept. 16 – The win against Cal State Fullerton in Los Angeles was Ohio State's first win on the West Coast in nine games all-time.
- Oct. 21 – Ohio State shuts out Indiana in Bloomington, Ind., for the first time in program history.
- Nov. 4 – Ohio State sets the program record for unbeaten streak at eight-consecutive matches. The Buckeyes would extend that to 15 before their next loss.
- Nov. 4 – The seven-member Ohio State senior class becomes the all-time winningest class in program history. The OSU seniors would end their four-year careers with a record of 51-26-12.
- Nov. 11 – The shootout win over Indiana gave Ohio State its second Big Ten Championship (2000).
- Nov. 28 – Ohio State hosts a second-round NCAA tournament game for the first time in program history.
- Dec. 2 – Ohio State plays its first game in December in program history.
- Dec. 9 – With the win over Bradley, the Buckeyes set the school record for home winning percentage in a season at .850 (8-1-1).
- Dec. 14 – Ohio State makes its first appearance in the NCAA College Cup.
- Dec. 14 – In the 1-0 win over Massachusetts, the Buckeyes played in front of 8,611 fans – the largest crowd in program history.
- Dec. 15 – Ohio State is honored with its first two first-team All-Americans in program history.
- Dec. 16 – Ohio State makes its first appearance in the NCAA national championship game.
- Dec. 17 – A school-record three Buckeyes are chosen for the MLS combine.
- Jan. 18 – Junior Roger Espinoza is selected 11th overall and senior Eric Brunner is selected 16th in the MLS SuperDraft, becoming the two highest-drafted Buckeyes in program history. They are the ninth OSU men's soccer players drafted overall, all this decade.
