Expenditure Accounts

The attached Ordinance No. 1734, An Ordinance Amending the 2012 Budget for the City of Omak by Adding BARS Accounts for Utility Revenues and Expenditures for Proper Accounting of Utility Tax Revenues is forwarded for your consideration.

The City Current Expense Fund imposes a Business and Occupation (B&O) Tax on the business operations of utilities that operate within the City of Omak. including the Water, Sewer, Garbage and Storm Drain utilities that are proprietary funds within the City. This B&O Tax is not a sales tax, but a tax on the gross revenues of the utility operations. In the past, we have collected these utility taxes in a manner that would be more suited to collection of a sales tax. This was done using the Utility Billing System, and having that program calculate the amount of the utility tax that should be collected and paid at the time of bill payment. These funds were then collected, and deposited directly into the Current Expense Fund, bypassing the proprietary fund that was responsible for the actual payment of the B&O Tax.

At this time we propose to begin to deposit the amounts collected to pay the B&O Tax incurred by the proprietary funds into the respective funds, and then have the actual payment to the Current Expense Fund made by a monthly deposit from the Water, Sewer, Garbage and Storm Drain funds into the Current Expense and into the correct BARS Account lines to properly report this revenue.

The effect of this change will be to increase both the revenue and the expenses of the Proprietary funds because the revenues collected will be properly recorded in the proprietary fund, and the expenses incurred with likewise be properly recorded. The amount of the deposit into the Current Expense fund will not change.

I support this Ordinance and urge its adoption.

ORDINANCE No. <u>1734</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2012 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF OMAK BY ADDING BARS ACCOUNTS FOR UTILITY REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR PROPER ACCOUNTING OF UTILITY TAX REVENUES

WHEREAS, the City of Omak adopted the 2012 Budget by passage of Ordinance No. 1730 on December 19, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the City levies a utility tax on the Water, Sewer, Storm Drain and Garbage Utilities as provided in various sections of the Revised Code of Washington; and

WHEREAS, previously, the City has deposited the Utility Taxes directly into the Current Expense Fund at the time of receipt without recognizing these as revenues and expenditures of the proprietary funds; and

WHEREAS, Utility Taxes are a tax upon the revenues of each of the separate utilities, and not a sales tax on the service provided and as such, it is most appropriate that the revenues represented by the Utility Taxes be deposited into the respective funds, and the payment of the utility taxes be made from the proprietary funds to the Current Expense Fund on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create and appropriate anticipated revenues and expenditures into these various funds in order that the revenues and expenditures of the Water, Sewer, Storm Drain and Garbage Funds be properly stated and reported; and

WHEREAS, said expenditures are not one of the emergencies specifically enumerated in RCW 35A.33.080; and

WHEREAS, the City of Omak is desirous of amending its budget pursuant to RCW 35A.33.090.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OMAK DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Ordinance No. 1730 adopting the 2012 Budget, shall be amended to include changes to the budget as shown in Attachment 'A' of this ordinance.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage by Council by a vote of one more than the majority of all Councilmembers, approval by the Mayor and publication as required by law.

Another recording unit in the patrol cars went down and had to be removed from the patrol car. That is the third unit that no longer functions. What does that mean? It means that the patrol officers will be spending more time in court. With the video units we spent virtually no time in court on DWI's and like offenses. Video does not lie! I will be receiving more citizen complaints on vehicles stops. Which will need to be investigated taking up valuable time and resources. With video, it is a simple matter of pulling the tape, viewing the video and when the officer is saying yes sir, no sir and the offender is calling the officer every name in the book, the offender has no complaint. If the officer is wrong and corrective action needs to be taken, video doesn't lie. This is giant step backwards.

I worked with the PUD's wireless networking department to trouble shoot and repair connectivity conflicts' with their wireless network and the VPN system owned by the city. The visitors' center has a video surveillance system that monitors their parking lot, the front entrance and vending machines and the figurines and statues that the Tribe installed in East Side Park. There was a frequency conflict that was solved by shutting down the city's system and connecting to the PUD's system. This connection was provided free of charge by the PUD. This connection allows for a video stream directly to the Police department for monitoring of the camera.

I have been working with electrician Butch Mitchell on the installation of the upgraded lights in the Police Department. There was \$4000 budgeted for this project which will only do a portion of the office. I am working with Butch to redo his original proposal to maximize the product with the money available.

On January 4th Officer Tallant went under the knife and received surgery on a herniated disc in his back. Officer Tallant was released from the hospital the following day and returned home. He is walking and doing well after the surgery. Officer Tallant is scheduled to be away from work through March.

Officer Busching is in the final stages of preemployment testing and background investigation for the Washington State Department of Wildlife. On January 5th he

completed and passed his Polygraph and Psychological tests and is scheduled for a full physical and Medical exam on January 12th.
