King's Shut Your Mouth. Other artists include The Martin Davis Band with their hot song, Take My Love, Gary Brown with Family Reunion, The Tim Clark Band with What's Up With That, The Tommy Black with Tommy's newly penned Lucky Me and The Carolina Breakers with Better Luck Next Time. You will also find music from several newcomers, Barry Herndon & The Party Nuts with Don't Play That Song, Sweet T with Good For What Ails Ya and Super Blues Xplosion with a Robben Ford tune, Tired Of Talkin'.
