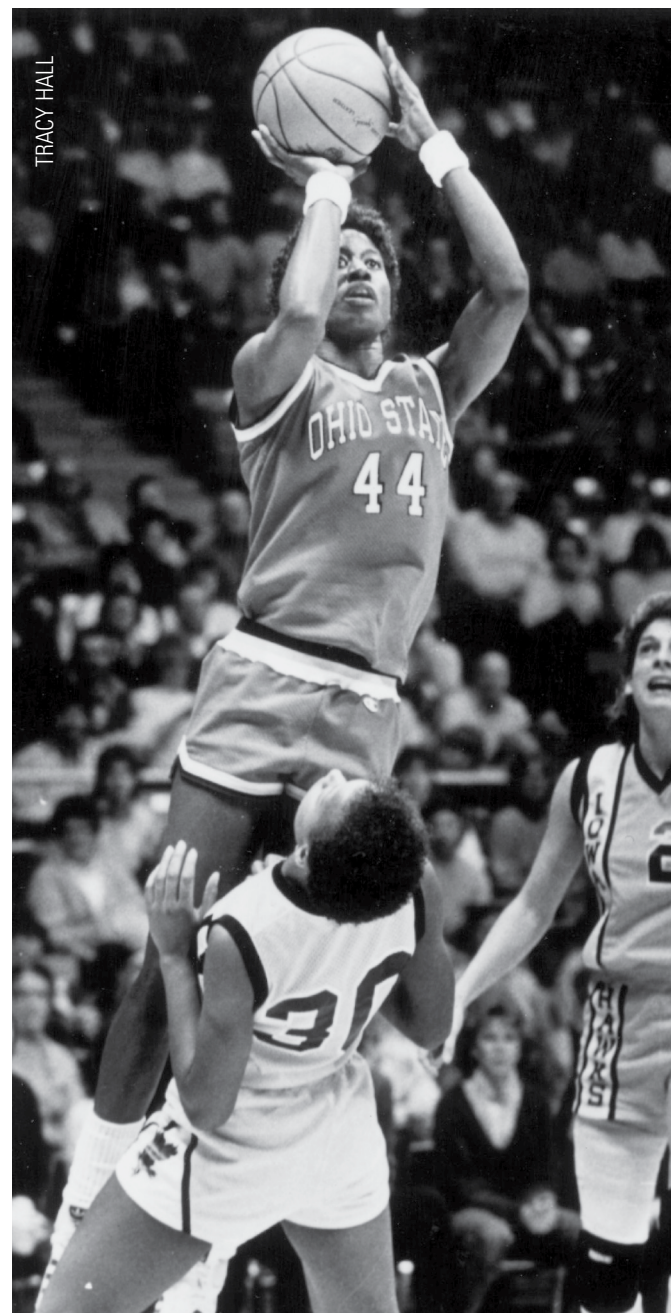

BUCKEYE CLASSIC

The Buckeye Classic is a tournament hosted by Ohio State that dates back to 1983. The event ran from 1983 until the 1994-95 season, skipping 1993-94. The 2003-04 season marked the first time in nine years the Buckeye Classic has been held in Columbus and the first time under head coach Jim Foster. The tradition continued in 2004-05 with Bradley, Detroit, Ohio State and Yale meeting Thanksgiving weekend in historic St. John Arena. OSU won its second-consecutive Buckeye Classic, going 2-0 on the weekend with wins over both Yale and Bradley and won again in 2008 by virtue of wins over Boston University and Dayton. The Buckeye Classic rebirth turned its seventh season in 2009, welcoming IUPUI, Cal-Berkeley and Southern University to St. John Arena. Ohio State defeated IUPUI in the first round before defeating No. 15 California in the championship game. No Buckeye Classic is scheduled for 2010.

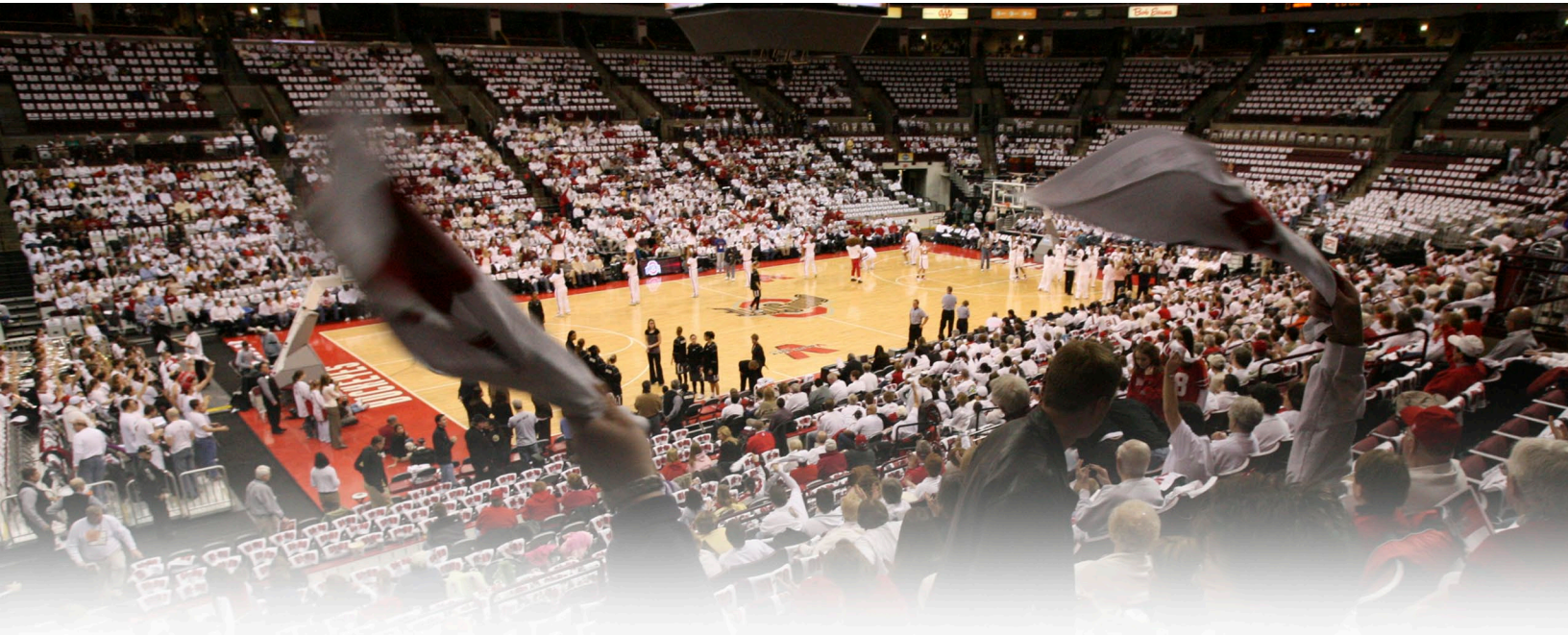

HISTORY

St. John Arena played host to its final season as the home of Ohio State women's basketball in 1997-98 after 24 years.

Feb. 22, 1998 capped a curtain call season for the Buckeyes in St. John Arena, and an era where over the previous 24 years, seven Big Ten championships were claimed, four All-Americans graced the court and another seven alumnae gained all-conference honors.

CONSTRUCTION

Completed in November of 1956 at a cost of less than \$4 million, the 13,276-seat structure is named for former OSU men's basketball coach and athletics director, L.W. St. John.

CAPACITY

Over the years, the capacity of the arena fluctuated. The original mark of 13,491 has gone as high as 13,681 and as low as the present figure of 13,276.

AMENITIES

Prior to the start of the 1987-88 season, a \$1.2 million scoreboard, featuring the latest in computer graphics at the time, was installed. At the same time, new corner scoreboards and a new lighting system were added.

THE ATMOSPHERE

With the most distant seat only 155 feet from the center circle and no posts or obstructions to block the sight lines, storied St. John Arena remains one of college basketball's most respected basketball theaters.

PRESENT-DAY USAGE

Now that the Ohio State men's and women's basketball teams have moved to Value City Arena, St. John Arena serves as the home of the Ohio State men's and women's volleyball, men's and women's gymnastics and wrestling teams.

A RETURN HOME

The 2002-03 season saw a return to historic St. John Arena for the Buckeyes. Ohio State faced then-No. 17/18 Texas Jan. 5 and Big Ten foe Michigan Feb. 27 in St. John. Ohio State beat the Longhorns, 70-66, and wrapped up the regular-season portion of its schedule with a 70-55 victory over the Wolverines.

The 2003-04 Buckeyes continued the pattern and played two games St. John Arena, earning two victories. The first was an 88-45 win vs. Wright State Dec. 18 and a 57-46 victory against Northwestern Feb. 19.

The Buckeyes again called St. John Arena home for three games in 2004-05, topping St. Joseph's in the Preseason WNIT, 76-29, and winning the Buckeye Classic with victories over Yale (80-43) and Bradley (86-52).

Ohio State paid another victorious visit to its former home in 2005-06, claiming its third consecutive Buckeye Classic tournament win. The Buckeyes defeated Nicholls in round one and Western Illinois in the title game.

The Buckeyes claimed their fourth Buckeye Classic title in a row in 2006-07 with wins over Cornell and Montana and hosted the event again last season with games against Colgate and Auburn.

In 2008, Ohio State once again claimed the Classic title with wins over Boston University and Dayton and again in 2009 with wins over IUPUI and California.
