DESIGNATION OF THE UNITED STATES ARMY ACQUISITION SUPPORT CENTER AS A DIRECT REPORTING UNIT

- **1.** Effective 16 October 2006, the United States Army Acquisition Support Center (USAASC) (UIC: W27PAA) is designated as a Direct Reporting Unit of the Assistant Secretary of the Army for Acquisition, Logistics, and Technology (ASA(AL&T)).
- 2. USAASC supports the readiness of the Army's warfighter by providing manpower and personnel resource support to assigned Program Executive Officers and Direct Reporting Program Managers who, under the direction of the Army Acquisition Executive, continually improve our Army's combat capability through all stages of materiel development. USAASC also develops a professional acquisition workforce and supports the acquisition community at all levels.
- **3.** Effective 16 October 2006, the provisions of Headquarters, Department of the Army General Orders No. 2002-9, dated 30 September 2002, inconsistent with this general order are hereby superseded.
