

The Josephine Foundation Mission Statement

The Josephine Foundation is an organization, founded in 2002 and incorporated in 2004, to honor and remember Josephine Koslosky. Josephine was a woman who believed that by using arts and sports programs, young people and adults can reach for their dreams regardless of their background and financial status and be successful. She believed if people were allowed to chase their dreams, anything was possible when given the opportunity. Josephine encouraged everyone to get involved with the arts and sports programs in their communities. She trusted that people could help each other raise funds to keep these programs alive and still have a great time doing it, all without it being a burden to one's time or finances. Remembering Josephine's work with the children of East New York, Brooklyn in the 1960s, 70s and 80s, this Foundation strives to keep her ideals alive.

Through our annual events and works, The Josephine Foundation raises money and distributes 100% of these funds to help give individuals and approved programs an opportunity to achieve their goals in life. Through the disciplines of properly run music, arts and sports programs, young people and adults can reach for their dreams regardless of race, creed, nationality, gender, age or financial status. The Foundation will distribute the money raised, by awarding grants at its Annual Gala each Spring/Summer. In addition, we will use special performing arts projects to raise funds and support 501(c) (3) charities providing support for medical, quality of life and disaster relief throughout the world.

The Josephine Foundation aims to show people how to enjoy getting involved and working together, without it burdening anyone's time or finances. Our goal is to grow by raising and distributing 10% more than the previous year. We will raise these funds through private donations, fundraisers, concerts, shows, events, public grants and awards. While achieving our goal, we will focus on bringing all people and communities, nationwide and worldwide, closer together.

In addition to grants, the Foundation bestows non-monetary awards recognizing outstanding service and performance. Our annual Recognition Awards and Chairman's Honorees applaud the service of people and programs that excel in areas consistent within our mission statement. The annual "Josie" Awards recognize excellence in the area of arts and sports.

In sum, The Josephine Foundation endeavors to become and remain synonymous with various good will activities, positive deeds and great events throughout the year.

As of June 2015, in its short time in existence, The Josephine Foundation has been responsible for more than 2.9 million dollars in grants, donations and/or services to deserving programs and individuals. The IRS and New York State recognized The Josephine Foundation as an official 501(c) (3) Public Charity Organization and non profit Group, effective August 10, 2004. In 2009, after a five-year review, the Foundation was granted permanent 501(c) (3) status by the IRS.

John S. Marino, M.D.

Dr. John S. Marino is an award winning oncologist and hematologist in Lake Success, New York and is affiliated with multiple hospitals in the area, including North Shore University Hospital and St. Francis Hospital.

Dr. Marino earned his medical degree from New York Medical College with honors. He thencompleted his internships at North Shore University and Memorial Sloan Kettering Hospitals. His Internal Medicine residency was completed at Northshore University and Memorial Sloan Kettering Hospitals. His Medical Oncology Fellowship was completed at Montefiore, Albert Einstein and North Shore University Hospitals.

He has served the community as a medical oncologist, with over twenty five years of dedication. He is an award winning physician who was named to The Castle Connolly Top Doctors: New York Metro Area for the years 1998 - 2008, 2010 – 2014. He was awarded The Patients' Choice Award for 2008 - 2009, 2011 – 2013 and The Compassionate Doctor Recognition Award 2011 – 2013. He also received The Top 10 Doctor Recognition for the State of New York 2014.

Dr. Marino is a gifted and valued member of the medical community that has made a difference in the lives of many who he has touched with his work of over 35 years as an award winning and caring physician.



Frank P. Petrone

Frank P. Petrone was first elected Huntington Town supervisor in 1993 and has been re-elected four times since then. His more than 20 year tenure has been marked by sound fiscal management, community redevelopment, innovative economic and housing initiatives, dedication to preserving the environment and open space and major capital projects that further enhance the Town's outstanding quality of life.

Prior to to becoming Supervisor, Mr. Petrone worked for more than 18 years in public service. Past positions include Assistant Suffolk County Executive under three administrations, Director of Environmental Control for the Town of Huntington, Chief of Staff to the Suffolk County Legislature, and most notably as Regional Director of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). As Region II Director of FEMA, Mr. Petrone was instrumental in developing FEMA's Hurricane Preparedness Program and guided federal policy on disaster mitigation plans. During Hurricane Gloria, Mr. Petrone managed the response and recovery plan for FEMA on Long Island.

The Supervisor holds two Master's Degrees, an M.A. in Higher Education Administration from the University of Denver, and a M.P.A. in Public Administration/Policy from Long Island University. In addition, he holds a B.S. from SUNY Albany, an A.A.S. from Staten Island Community College, and an honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters from Five Towns College.

The Supervisor has two grown children. He and his wife, Patricia, reside in Commack.

Frank P. Petrone's almost twenty-year tenure as Town Supervisor is distinguished by a record of sound, prudent financial management, a commitment to revitalization, housing for seniors and moderate income working families. He has sponsored major capital projects and improvements to Huntington's infrastructure, as well as lead the way on open space preservation and improving Huntington's active and passive parks. Supervisor Petrone's efforts have enhanced what is widely recognized as Huntington's outstanding quality of life.



Bobby Susser

Bobby Susser, is a multi-award winning, American songwriter, record producer, and performer. Born in New York City, to middle class Jewish American parents, Susser grew up in the borough of Queens, and attended Jamaica High School. Susser graduated from Queens College, City University of New York, Magna cum laude, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in communications. He received a Master's degree in communications in early childhood education from Teachers College, Columbia University, where he studied with Canadian scholar, and communication theorist, Marshall McLuhan.

He has written and produced original, easy-to-learn, award winning children's songs since 1972, as well as internationally acclaimed popular songs for all ages. To date, he has sold over 5 million CDs, produced 25 albums, and entertained and taught lessons to scores of children, through his songs. Along the way, he received dozens of awards from respected Children's, Parenting Music, and Educational organizations.

Her love of music never diminished and in her 50's, she somehow managed to get invited onto the stage of the Broadway production of 42nd street where she made sure to do a few time steps! She could finally say that she "danced on Broadway". Her greatest "talents" however, were her compassion, unselfishness, courage and optimism. The recipients of the Elaine Agin award demonstrate the true essence of these special qualities.
