PAPYRUS seeks to work with communities across the UK to tackle the stigma that surrounds suicide and to promote mental health and wellbeing among young people and those who care for and work with young people. We are delighted to welcome Ged Flynn, PAPYRUS Chief Executive, who will help participants to:

- examine our attitudes to and beliefs about suicide
- explore what causes stigma around suicide
- increase awareness of the scale of young suicidal ideation and behaviours 22develop knowledge, skills, and attitudes which may help prevent young suicide &
- think about developing local responses in our own dioceses, parishes, schools, communities, networks and organisations to help to #saveyounglives
