1. Origin and growth of GRI Library

The Gandhigram Rural Institute Library was established in 1956. It moved to the



present building in 1987, stocking over 1.5 lakh books. The Library is named after the Founder Vice-Chancellor Dr.G.Ramachandran. The total area of the Library building is about 12600 sq.ft. The Library is fully computerised for circulation and searching of books with for **SOUL** (Software University Libraries), developed by INFLIBNET Centre (An IUC of the University Grants Commission), Ahmedabad. Intrernet and e-mail facility to the University

community, Barcode technology has been used for member id and circulation of books. The Library is state-of-the-art of library with latest technology of surveillance security system. The reference collection of the Library is continuously updated, and augmented with the acquisition of CD-ROM databases and access to on-line databases on Internet. On-line Public Access Catalogue facility is available at the Reference Desk on the Ground Floor of the Library. The digitization of library documents such as Ph.D Theses, Dissertation and Projects is in progress. The Library subscribes to about 300 current periodicals. Library subscribes to Indiastat.com online statistical database, and has access to approximately 5000 online full text journals, is available through UGC- INFONET with 10 MBPS connectivity. This library is also member in DELNET. The library has Digital Knowledge Lab is equipped with 40 computers.
