FAMILY TRACHYPACHIDAE

This family includes two genera, *Trachypachus* with three species in western North America and one species in Eurasia, and *Systolosoma* Solier with two Chilean species. Members of *Trachypachus* are usually found on dry, more or less shaded soil, often under dead leaves. Nothing is known about their feeding habits.

This group has been included within the Carabidae for a long time. During the last two decades, however, some authors have highlighted many character states suggesting that *Trachypachus* and *Systolosoma* are more closely related to the Hydradephaga than to the Carabidae (see Kavanaugh [1986] for a different point of view). The two species inhabiting Canada have been redescribed by Lindroth (1961).
