Total of 1,062 points for 22 games is modern Notre Dame record, exceeded only by 1,327 points scored in 40 games in 1908-09 season. Average of 48.27 points a game is all-time Notre Dame record.

Total of 81 points against Monmouth is all-time Notre Dame individual game record.

Capt. Eddie Riska's 174 points made him high man for third straight year. He missed five games with a broken foot. His three-year total of 608 points is second only to Johnny Moir's 780 for three seasons. Moir made mark in 1935-6, 1936-7, 1937-8.

Team overcame severe handicaps to make its great record, which advanced George E. Keogan's 18-year percentage from .770 to .771. Keogan was ordered to restrict his activities because of a heart ailment following the Illinois game. He was confined to bed the last month of the season, with Ray J. Meyer, 1936-7 and 1937-8 captain, taking charge as his assistant. Injuries to George Sobek and Riska added to the season's difficulties. Wisconsin's undisputed Big Ten champions won a one-point decision at Madison. Illinois won an overtime. The Irish broke even with the other three teams to win from them.

Notre Dame won 16 out of 22 games for a percentage of .727. The Fighting Irish won 15 out of 20 collegiate starts (breaking even with Great Lakes) for a .750 mark.

The total of 1045 points is the fourth highest ever scored by a Notre Dame team and the second highest for 22 games or fewer. Last year's quintet, which also played 22 games, made 1062. Opponents made 906 points, the most ever made against a Notre Dame team, indicating the trend toward higher scoring this year.

The 1941-42 record left Coach George Keogan's percentage at .768, for 19 years as compared with .771 at the end of last season.

Longest winning streak was eight games, and the Irish won 12 out of 13 during January and February. They did not lose more than two in a row at any time.

Notre Dame scored an average of 51.83 points for 12 home games as compared with 42.3 away from their own courts as compared with 37.58 at N.D.

Butler's victory was the first January defeat suffered by the Irish since Jan. 34, 1938 when Minnesota won, 37 to 25, at Minneapolis. Notre Dame has not lost a January home game since Butler's 27 to 25 win, Jan. 14, 1933. In 19 seasons Keogan has lost only 23 January games and 24 February games, winning 96 each month. The Irish lost only one game out of 12 at home in 1941-42.
