BROKERS TIP, much the best, began very slowly, saved some ground when moving up leaving the backstretch, but lost some on the stretch turn, then went to the inside and, responding to urging and overcoming interference, was up to win in the final strides after a long and rough drive. HEAD PLAY, rated close to the pace, went to the front easily, came out when increasing his lead on the stretch turn and bumped the winner when holding on stubbornly. CHARLEY O., well in hand for three-quarters, challenged gamely, then tired, but held LADYSMAN safe. The latter raced wide most of the way, was under restraint for seven-eighths and failed to rally when hard urged. POMPONIOUS closed resolutely. SPICSON began slowly. KERRY PATCH tired. MR. KHAYYAM was never a factor. ISAIAH and DARK WINTER showed early speed. GOOD ADVICE quit badly and was pulled up.
