# **PREFACE**

The resignation of Thomas Lush from the House of Assembly, with effect from September 30, 1983, created a vacancy.

Subsequently, on November 15, 1983 a Writ of Election ordering the Election of a Member to serve in the House of Assembly for the Electoral District of Terra Nova was issued.

The Writ ordered Nominations concluded by November 26, 1983 and the Election held December 7, 1983.

Three candidates were nominated, each representing one of the political parties active in this Province; viz. Liberals, Progressive Conservatives, and New Democrats.

The Notice of Grant of Poll is included in this document to help relate statistics to people and places.

Our thanks to the many election officers who conducted the By-Election so very well.
