Transfer fees are, of course, open to interpretation, given the reluctance of many clubs to publicise them, or the tendency to slap on signing-on fees and projected wages in an effort to gild the lily. Such variations make any sort of consistent study of them difficult, but observing the way "record" fees have changed over the years makes for an interesting diversion.

- 4: Local sources reported that Chesterfield paid what they received for Joe Ball. The Bury historian Peter Cullen has confirmed that £400 was paid by The Shakers, but it seems incredible that Chesterfield's notoriously slim resources stretched to such an amount.
- 5: Local sources say £5,000 the deal may have involved a down-payment and topups for appearances.
- 7: As reported at the time. A club representative at Chesterfield's 1998 AGM said that only £85,000 had been paid. Increments may have been due with appearances.
- 8: Deal appears to have been £100,000 plus Tony Lormor, who Chesterfield were said to have valued at around £70,000. A record fee, of sorts, then, but difficult to express as a money figure alone.
- 9: Fee paid in total was £1738 this figure includes Sliman's share of benefit at City, which Chesterfield paid.

Interestingly, for a so-called 'goalkeeper factory', only two of Chesterfield's record fees received have been banked for the transfer of a custodian (Stevenson and Brown). Seven of those who left for a record fee were wingers.

Chesterfield's long decline from being a good Second Division side in 1950 to being an average Fourth Division one in the mid-60s is emphasised by there being nearly twenty years between the record purchases of Harrison and Bellamy.

The situation in the wake of the Bosman ruling make it most unlikely that the club will pay such a fee as the did for Jason Lee for a long time to come!
