He stood not far from the table where Humphrey Bogart signed his original contract with Warner Bros. studio, in the commissary famous for the movie stars, directors and deal-makers that have regularly eaten there throughout decades of Hollywood heyday.

For Schulman, it may have been just the dining room of the company where he has worked for over 20 years (a rarity itself in Hollywood), and where he is now an executive vice president and general counsel. For his audience, some 40 SFS alumni from the 1940s through the 2002s, the glamour of Hollywood paled next to the legacy that they shared and their goal: to help raise the final \$12 million in the School's capital fund-raising effort.

George Bernstein '64

George Bernstein '64 knows that academic institutions are beholden to alumni for their financial support. As Interim Dean of the School of Liberal Arts at Tulane University in New Orleans, he was familiar with that lesson even before Hurricane Katrina devastated Tulane. He knows it's true at Sidwell Friends, too, even though wealth is often perceived as a hallmark of the school.

Bernstein understands that Sidwell Friends actually ranks lower than its sister schools in endowment and donations to its annual funds. His efforts to change that began in 2000, with a drive that raised \$10 million for endowment. The endeavor proved that SFS could mobilize its community around a substantial campaign.

"We knew that this current campaign was a big, big stretch for us," Bernstein remembers, "but we felt confident we had the parent and alumni base."

The goals originally emerged from the Board of Trustees strategic plan of 1998 and the master plan for the campus of 2002. The first priority of the strategic plan was raising money for "faculty salaries and other things to improve faculty retention and morale, and to build up the endowment," says Bernstein, who has two older brothers, Daniel '55 and Alan '59. The success of that effort convinced the Board that a major campaign was possible. Members set a goal of \$56 million, with \$30 million earmarked for endowment and for faculty salaries, benefits and professional development, and the rest for the glaring needs among the school's

"This is far more ambitious, and the amount of money we're talking about is way beyond any goal we've set before," Bernstein says. So far, the school has raised \$44

million. He's confident it can bring in the remaining \$12 million because "there's an alumni base we still haven't tapped.

But the School cannot afford those updates within its existing budget

"Everyone has an exaggerated view of the resources Sidwell has," Bernstein says. "Our endowment is still very low compared to any of our



peer institutions. We do things that other schools don't – we provide an amazing amount of financial aid, and some of that comes out of endowment, some of it comes out of operating money. The message that we need to get out is that we do these amazing things, and we're not that rich, certainly if rich is measured by

"Arts and athletics have not been well funded in past campaigns," he says. "But these are real needs, and will make a real difference in what we can offer students, and a real difference in whether we get the students we want. This is not window

George Marcou '75

George Marcou '75 believes that every contribution in support of Sidwell Friends is critical, regardless of the amount. But he wants alumni to understand that their dollars are worth more than just cash to the school.

"First, anything is appreciated," Marcou stresses. "Second, there are large giftgiving foundations and organizations that have triggers based on overall participation."

That means that when an organization applies to a foundation for a grant or other funding, one measure of its worthiness is reflected in how many of its own community have stepped up with their own money. "If you are the Gates Foundation, or Foundation X," Marcou explains, "one thing

you will ask is, 'if your charity or school is so great, what is your overall percentage of participation?' Even a modest amount helps us with our overall percentages. Large foundations will look to that parameter in determining what level they will support."

"A good way to put it is that every dollar counts, and every percentage point counts," says Marcou, a lawyer and partner with Kilpatrick Stockton. In the School's last major campaign, Friends Stand Up, alumni made up 30 percent of donors who raised a total of \$14 million.

The School counts seven Marcous among its students including Marcou's sons, John '18 and George '15. His sister Mary '76 and brothers Andrew '78 and Matthew '81 live in the Washington, D.C. area. A third brother lives overseas.

"My brother John ('74) now lives in Jakarta, Indonesia," Marcou says. "There are Sidwell graduates all over the world. So the regional gift committees are a way to reach people who have moved away and live all over.

"Sidwell is no longer a local thing for them," he continues. "They're removed physically. They've got their own schools that their kids go to. I respect that. What I return to is that there's an element of payback. And we're overdue."

He explains that he wants to be among the first to rectify that.

"Sidwell Friends has played an important role in my life and in my four siblings' lives, and now my two kids' lives," Marcou explains. "I felt that up until recently, the school has done a poor job, candidly, in getting its endowment and physical plant in order. The effort is now payback for everything the school has done for me and my family over the last three decades."

Adam Bernstein '81

Adam Bernstein '81 vividly remembers going to school in the old Middle Schooland so do his children, Danielle '10 and Liza '12.

"I went to school there and the building hadn't changed in 30 years," says Bernstein, who has two other children, Brenner '15 and Thea '19. "We learned and did great, but our physical environment hadn't changed in so long. Now the students have an appreciation of their surroundings, and can learn from those surroundings, and that's what I didn't have. But my kids do have it, and I'm proud of

"I'm certainly getting the full benefit of the new Middle School for my children," he adds. To return the favor, Bernstein took a leadership position with the alumni regional fund-raising drive that will power the next stages of the School's

"These plans create an excitement, whether they're for athletic or arts facilities, or a gym or classrooms," says Bernstein, who is president of The Bernstein Companies, a commercial real estate management company. "They're not just new, but innovative. That's especially true of the classroom spaces.

He knows that it's diffiuclt for some alumni to understand the scope of change necessary when they are scattered across the country.

"The regional committees will try to create a sense of community for alumni who are so far away," Bernstein says.

"It's easy to get out there with alumni and say 'we had a great experience,'" he adds. "It's even more special now. As the world and schools become more competitive, we've got to have the facilities to compete for teachers and even for students sometimes. We've got to have

And Here's What You Wanted to Know

If you ask for an opinion, you'll surely get one. This has never been truer than when we asked the Sidwell Friends community for advice on the Annual Funds and Dollars for Scholars fund-raising programs. First, our thanks to everyone who completed the on-line survey. We have already incorporated many of your suggestions into this year's Annual Funds appeals, and your feedback will certainly be part of our future plans.

One response was loud and clear in the survey: there's a good deal of confusion about the exact nature of the School's fundraising programs. People want to know how Fair Share relates to the Annual Funds; or what Dollars for Scholars means; or what is *Call Us Friends*?

With that in mind, we offer a brief primer on the three programs that generate financial support for SFS:

The Annual Fund provides yearly, unrestricted operating support. It is comprised of four funds: the Alumni Fund (contributions from alumni), the Fair Share Fund (contributions from current parents), the Grandparent's Fund, and the Parents of Alumni and Friends Fund. This newsletter includes lists of gifts to the Annual Funds thus far in our fiscal year. If you haven't made your contribution yet, please make your gift by June 30th. So far, 21 percent of alumni and 78 percent of current parents have pledged.

Dollars for Scholars raises money for student financial aid. It does so with an annual calendar of fund-raising events: the Next to New sale, the on-line and live auctions, the golf and tennis tournaments and the Variety Show. Dollars for Scholars is completely separate from the Annual Fund program. Check your email and the SFS Web site for dates and times of events.

Call Us Friends is the current comprehensive campaign. This \$56 million initiative is designed to support three goals: capital improvements, endowment and Annual Funds. Yes, the Annual Funds counts in the campaign. Any gift you make to the Annual Funds is included in the overall campaign goal. We must raise only another \$12 million to complete the Call Us Friends campaign.

Director of the Department of the Environment; several Montgomery County, Md., council members, and officials from the office of Congresswoman Doris Matsui.
