Formed in 1934-35 as the 25. Infanterie-Division (1. Welle) by expansion of Infanterie-Regiment 13 of the old Reichswehr, this division participated in the campaign against Poland in September and October 1939, transferred to the German-Luxembourg border for the western campaign in May 1940, and in October 1940 from the demarcation line in France back to its home station in Ludwigsburg, Wehrkreis V. Reorganized as a motorized infantry division on November 1, 1940, in June 1941 it went to Poland for the attack on Russia, crossing the border in the central sector, advancing from Rovno southeast to Zaporozhe, then taking part in the encirclement of Kiev, the advance to Orel, and position defense on the Oka and Zusha Rivers, where it suffered heavy losses during the winter of 1942 and spring of 1943. The division was redesignated the 25. Panzergrenadier-Division on May 19, 1943, when a Führer directive

converted all motorized infantry divisions into panzer grenadier divisions. After heavy losses in the Kursk offensive in the summer of 1943, the division was engaged west of Smolensk. Although there are no records of the division available dated later than December 31, 1943, the situation maps of Lage Ost, West, and Frankreich show that from January to July 1944 the division participated in the defense of the Dubrovno area, returned to Germany in July 1944 for rehabilitation, and in the autumn was ordered to the western front. From November 1944 to January 1945 the division, augmented by the 107. Panzer-Brigade, defended the Saarlautern and Kaiserslautern areas. In February 1945 it returned to the eastern front, defended the Küstrin area from February to April 1945, and then withdrew to Oranienburg north of Berlin where it was destroyed in the closing days of the war.
