- Water Shrew (Neomys fodiens)
- Bank Vole (Clethrionomys glareolus)
- Field Vole (Microtus agrestis)
- Wood Mouse (Apodemus sylvaticus)
- 15 bat species including four BAP priorities
- Water vole (Arvoicola terrestris)
- Harvest Mouse (micromys minutus)
