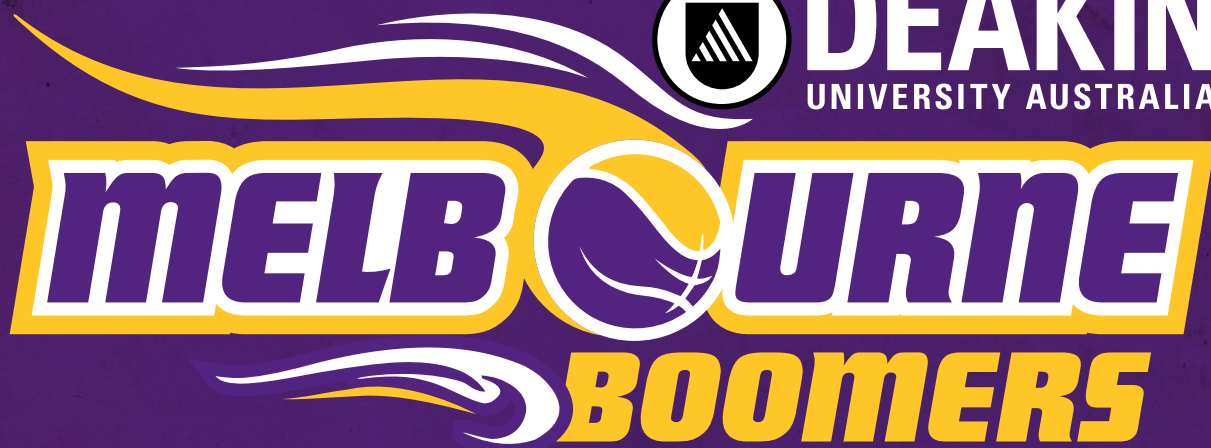
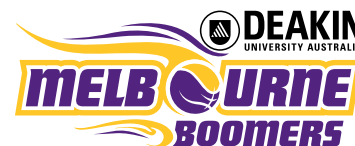

## Head Coach Guy Molloy

As Head Coach of the Australian Under 17 Men’s team, Molloy guided the young group to the silver medal at the 2012 FIBA Under 17 World Championships. While in charge of the Victoria Metro Under 18 Men’s team, Molloy had continued success, winning three consecutive Australian Under 18 National Championships between 2007 and 2009. Molloy got his coaching break in the WNBL in 1989 with the Canberra Capitals before serving as Head Coach of the Perth Breakers between 1993 and 1996, winning the 1995 WNBL Coach of the Year award.

From the WNBL, Molloy moved to the NBL, landing the head role at the Cairns Taipans between 2001 and 2005. He was an assistant to Brian Goorjian during the South Dragons 2009 championships season. In his first season with the Boomers, Molloy led Melbourne to the WNBL semi-finals.
