## RÁITEAS AN CHATHAOIRLIGH

Lá deirdidh na bliana 2000, thosaigh Raidió RTÉ ar a cheiliúradh 75 bliana de sheirbhís phoiblí. Ní amháin go ndeachtas siar go sultmhar ar bhóithrín na smaointe sna clár cheiliúrtha ach thugadar éachtaint ar ról lárnach an chraolacháin i saol na hÉireann ó bhlianta tosaigh an Stáit. Beart misniúil a bhí ann sa bhliain 1926 nuair a craoladh na clár dhúchasacha ba thúisce in Éirinn ar stáisiún beag raidió 2RN. Anois féin, trí RTÉ, tá ceithre sheirbhís náisiúnta raidió, trí chainéal teilifise agus raon bisiúil de láithreán Idirlín tagtha i gcomharbacht ar 2RN..

Is é gnó RTÉ seirbhís Éireannacha raidió agus teilifise, agus seirbhís nua-mheán a sholáthar do mhuintir na tire le raon agus caighdeán ábhar nach mbeadh ar fáil in aon chor dá mba é an critéar lom tráchtála an t-aon bhonn dár saothar. Faoi réir an phrlionsabail sin a ghlaicann Údarás RTÉ gach aon chinneadh. Tháinig comhaltaí nua an Údarás in oifig ar an 1 Meitheamh 2000 agus tuigmid go bhfuil dualgas ar an Údarás, sna cúig bliana romhainn, ár gcarolachán seirbhise poiblí a thabhairt isteach sa ré dhigiteach go muiníneach, fuinniúil, samhláioch. Sin é an dúshlán do RTÉ. Táim suite de go bhfuil an eagraíocht ag díriú ar an dúshlán sin agus é ina rún daingean a dheimhniú gurb é RTÉ a bheidh ina chéadrogha ag lucht éisteachta is feachana na hÉireann mar chraoltóir is mar léiritheoir.

Bunriachtanas é siúrail chistiúcháin sna blianta romhainn. Is mó an iomaiocht i ngach réimse den chraolachán agus de na meáin leictreonacha le himeacht gach bliana. Tá sé seo ríshoiléir as ráiteas airgeadais RTÉ. Sa bhliain a chríochnaigh 31 Nollaig seo caite, mhéadaigh an t-easnamh craolacháin go £23.213m, easnamh dofhulangtha ar fad mar atá ráite agam áit éigin eile. Nuair a áiríodh an t-ioncam uile, bhí easnamh £11.23m i gceist do ghrúpa RTÉ ag deireadh na bliana. Le heasnamh dá leithéid, caithfear costais a laghdú agus fáltas a mhéadú. San am chéanna, caithfidh RTÉ infheistiú i gcláir ardchaighdeáin chun lucht éisteachta a ghnóthú le feabhas buan ár gcuid sceideal. Is chuige sin a bhunaigh an tÚdarás Ciste Forbartha Clár a infheisteoidh £25m i léiriúchán dúchasach clár sna cúig bliana romhainn. Gníomh muiníne as scil agus talann léiritheoirí na tire é seo agus ní bheidh aon chraoltóir eile in Éirinn inchomórtais linn sa tsú seo.



## CHAIRMAN'S STATEMENT

RTÉ

On the last day of the year 2000, RTÉ Radio began its celebration of 75 years of service to the public. While the programmes marking that anniversary were nostalgic and entertaining, they also pointed to the central part that broadcasting has played in Irish life since the early years of the State. A brave beginning was made in 1926 when the small wireless station 2RN broadcast the first indigenous Irish programmes. Today, its descendants include four national radio services, three television channels, and a growing range of Internet sites.

RTÉ exists to give the people of this country Irish radio, television and new media services with a quality and range of content that simply would not be provided if a strictly commercial approach was the only basis for what we do. This principle guides all the decisions taken by the RTÉ Authority. The new Authority members came into office on 1 June, 2000 and we know that in the next five years the Authority must set a course to bring our public service broadcasting into the digital era with confidence, vigour and imagination. This is the challenge facing RTÉ. I am convinced that the organisation is stepping up to that challenge with the determination to ensure that RTÉ will continue to be the broadcaster and producer of first choice for Irish listeners and viewers.

Secure funding is the essential requirement for the future. Each sector of broadcasting and electronic communications becomes more competitive with every year that passes. That reality is starkly clear from RTÉ's financial statement. In 2000, the broadcasting deficit rose to £23.213 million, a figure that is, as I have said elsewhere, simply unsustainable. When all income is considered, the RTÉ group ended the year with a deficit of £11.23 million. The response to such a deficit demands that we reduce costs and increase revenues. At the same time, RTÉ must invest in high quality programmes to win audiences by guaranteeing the excellence of our schedules. That is why the Authority has created a Programme Development Fund to invest £25 million in indigenous programme-making over the next five years. This is an act of confidence in the talent and skill of Irish producers, and also a commitment which no other broadcaster in Ireland will rival.

Agus mé á scriobh seo, tá iarratas RTÉ ar tháille méadaithe ar cheadúnas teilifise á mheas ag an Aire. Léirigh RTÉ, sa chás a deineadh ar son méadaithe, conas a chaithfí an t-airgead breise d'fhoinn caighdeán ár seirbhísí clár a fheabhsú. Chun go bhfaigheadh an pobal an luach is fearr as tällé méadaithe ar cheadúnais, is gá na buntáistí a leanfaidh athruithe eagraiochta a bheith faoi réir. Mar thaca le léiriúchán breise is feabhsaithe do lucht éisteachta na hÉireann a chaithfear an bhrefis ionlán sna fáltais ó chistí poiblí.

Láistigh de RTÉ, tá dul chun cinn maith déanta in athstruchtúrú na heagraiochta. I rith an dá mhí dhéag seo caite, deineadh comhaontuithe le costais a laghdú agus eifeacht a fheabhsú. Trí chomhoibriú agus trí chomhchainteanna, tá an fhoireann agus an bhainistíocht ag diríú go stuama ar na dúshláin agus tá mórchlaochlú á dhéanamh ar RTÉ. Gabhaim buiochas go poiblí as na hiarrachtaí atá á ndéanamh ag gach aon duine in RTÉ chun na haidhmeanna, a cheapamar dúinn, féin a bhaint amach. Is annamh a aimsitear réiteach i leith athruithe gan bráca, ach dheimhnigh comhoibriú fiúntach go bhfuil cuid mhaith den mbóthar atá le cur dinn, siúlta againn.

Dhein an tAcht um Chraolachán, 2001, soláthar do thosú na teilifise talmháí digiti (TTD). I rith na bliana 2000, nuair a bhíothas ag feitheamh leis an acht nua, deineadh bunobair thábhachtach d'fhoinn a chinntíú go mbeifi in ann dul chun cinn a dhéanamh go tomhaiste faoi bhráid thosú TTD. Caithfidh an tÚdarás a pholasai a cheapadh agus a bheachtúanois do thosú seirbhísí nua dígilteacha. Beidh moltaí do chainéil bhreise le scrúdú agus cinní le déanamh maidir le cathain a thosófar ar chraoladh na gcainéil – ach iad a bheith faofa. Cuirfidh tosú na seirbhísí dígilteacha brú ar gach gné den eagraiocht – cruthaiocht, teicneolaiocht agus riarrachán – agus rachaidh na hathruithe fairsinge atá á ndéanamh in RTÉ anois chun sochair don phobal. Tráth spreagúil é seo i gcúrsai craolacháin agus táim deimhin de go n-éireoidh linn ionad lárnach a chinntíú do mheáin na seirbhise poiblí sa raon leathnaithe seirbhise atá gealta dúinn ag an teicneolaiocht dhigiteach.

As I write, RTÉ's application for an increased television licence fee is under consideration by the Minister. In arguing the case for an increase, RTÉ has demonstrated how the additional income will be used to raise the quality of our programme services. If the public is to receive maximum value in return for paying a higher licence fee, the benefits that flow from organisational change will have to be in place. All increased revenue from public funds will support more and better production for the Irish audience.

Within RTÉ, much progress has been made in restructuring the organisation. During the last twelve months, agreements have been reached to reduce costs and increase efficiency. Through collaboration and negotiation, staff and management have taken a rational approach to the challenges and RTÉ is, truly, undergoing a transformation. I want to record my appreciation of the efforts being made by everyone in RTÉ to achieve the goals we have set for ourselves. Reaching agreement on change is rarely trouble-free, but good co-operation has already advanced us far along the road we have to travel.

The Broadcasting Act, 2001 provides for the means of introducing digital terrestrial television (DTT). In the year 2000, much important groundwork was done in anticipation of the new act to ensure steady progress towards the start up of DTT. Now the Authority must decide and finalise its policy for the introduction of new digital services. This will call for examination of proposals for additional channels and for decisions about when the channels – once approved – can begin broadcasting. Every aspect of the organisation – creative, technological and administrative – will be tested by the introduction of digital services, and the public will derive the advantages of the far-reaching changes now being made in RTÉ. It is an exciting time in broadcasting and I am sure that we can secure a central place for public service media in the extended range of service that digital technology promises.

Bhí an tAire Ealaíon, Oidhreachta, Gaeltachta agus Oileán, Síle de Valera, buanseasmhach ina tacáiocht do chraolachán na seirbhisi poiblí, agus dá ionad ar leith i saol an chomhluadair, le linn na n-athruithe agus na héiginneachtaí go léir a bhain leis an tréimhse seo i stair an chraolacháin. Gabhaim buiochas ó chroí leis an Aire agus le hoifigigh a Roinne.

Ar deireadh, ba mhaith liom buiochas a ghabháil aris le bainistiocht agus foireann RTÉ as a ngairmiúlacht agus a ndúthracht i leith an chraolacháin seirbhise poiblí. Mar aon le comhaltaí an Údaráis, táim ag trúth le tortaí na dilseachta buaine sin.
