PATTERN NAME Laurel Crocheted Stole

SKILL LEVEL Intermediate

SIZES One size fits most

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approx. 73" x 18", not including fringe

MATERIALS

Yarn: *Polaris* by **Rozetti Yarns** (65% dralon, 31% wool, 4% payette; 50g/191 yds)

• 61002 Luna – 5 balls

Hook: US Size D/3/3.25mm OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE **Notions:** Tapestry needle

GAUGE Rnd 1 = approx. 2" square Save Time, Check Your Gauge

ABBREVIATIONS

ch chain double crochet dc double treble crochet dtr rep repeat single crochet sc skip sk slip stitch sl st space(s) sp(s) stitch(es) st(s) treble crochet tr

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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SPECIAL STITCHES

Double Treble Crochet (dtr): [Yo] 3 times, insert hook in st or sp indicated, yo, pull up a lp (5 lps on hook), [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] 4 times.

Beginning 4-Double Treble Cluster (beg 4-dtr cluster): Ch 4, holding back last lp of each st on hook, work 3 dtr in st or sp indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

4-Double Treble Cluster (4-dtr cluster): Holding back last lp of each st on hook, work 4 dtr in st or sp indicated, yo, pull through all lps on hook.

Attach yarn with a dc: Place slip knot on hook, yo, insert hook in st or sp indicated, [yo, pull up through 2 lps] twice.

NOTES

Dtr at ends of rnds counts as a ch-4. Invisibly weave in ends as work progresses.

STOLE

MOTIF 1 (Make 1)

Beg at center, ch 8, join to form ring.

Rnd 1 (Right Side): Working in ring, beg 4-dtr cluster, ch 7, dtr, ch 7, [4-dtr cluster, ch 7, dtr, ch 7] twice, 4-dtr cluster, ch 7, dtr, ch 3, dtr in first ch of beg ch-7 - 4 4-dtr clusters, 4 dtr.

Rnd 2: * Ch 7, sc in next ch-7, ch 7, (dtr, ch 5, dtr) in next dtr **, ch 7, sc in next ch-7, rep from * around ending at **, ch 3, dtr in dtr at end of Rnd 1 – 12 ch-7, 4, ch-5, 8 dtr. Fasten off.

SECOND & ALL REMAINING MOTIFS (Make 84) Rnd 1: Rep Rnd 1 of First Motif.

Note: Select either One-Sided Join or Two-Sided Join to complete Rnd 2. See Layout Chart for an explanation of which joining to use on each Motif.

One-Sided Join

Rnd 2: Ch 7, sc in next ch-7, ch 7, (dtr, ch 5, dtr) in next dtr, ch 7, [sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 7] twice, * (dtr, ch 2, dtr in corresponding corner sp on previously worked motif, ch 2, dtr) in next dtr *, [ch 3, dtr in next sp on previously worked motif, ch 3, sc in next ch-7 sp] twice, ch 3, dtr in next sp on previously worked motif, ch 3, rep between * once, ch 7, [sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 7] twice, (dtr, ch 5, dtr) in next dtr, ch 3, dtr in joining dtr on Rnd 1. Fasten off.

Two-Sided Join

Rnd 2: Ch 7, sc in next ch-7, ch 7, (dtr, ch 5, dtr) in next dtr, ch 7, [sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 7] twice, (dtr, ch 2, dtr in corresponding corner sp on previously worked motif, ch 2, dtr) in next dtr, *[ch 3, dtr in next sp on previously worked motif, ch 3, sc in next ch-7 sp] twice, ch 3, dtr in next sp on previously worked motif*, ch 3, (dtr, ch 2, dtr in corresponding ch-5 corner sp on previously worked motif, sk ch-5 corner sp on next previously worked motif, dtr in ch-5 corner sp of next previously worked motif, ch 2, dtr) in next dtr, rep between * once, (dtr, ch 2, dtr in corresponding corner sp on previously worked motif, ch 2, dtr) in next dtr, ch 3, dtr in joining dtr of Rnd 1. Fasten off.

LAYOUT AND ASSEMBLY

Assemble Motifs in the order shown from 1 through 85, starting at Row 1, Column 1 and working across from right to left (see Layout Chart). All Motifs in Row 1 are joined tog with a one-sided join. All motifs in Column 1 are also joined to the first Motif in the previous row with a one-sided join. The rem motifs are joined with a twosided join in the order shown.

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EDGING

Attach yarn with a dc on Right Side of Stole in center ch of next sp to the left of ch-5 sp at any outer corner of Stole, [ch 5, dc in center ch of next ch-7 sp] twice, ch 5, dc in center ch of ch-5 sp at next corner of same motif, ch 5, * dc in center ch of ch-5 sp at corner of next motif, [ch 5, dc in center ch of next ch-7] 3 times, ch 5, dc in center ch of ch-5 at next corner of same motif, ch 5, rep from * across to last motif on same side of Stole, dc in center ch of ch-5 sp at corner of last motif on this side, [ch 5, dc in center ch of next ch-7] 3 times, ch 5, [dc, ch 5] twice in center ch of ch-5 at last corner, {now working down next side of Stole, [ch 5, dc in center ch of next ch-7] 3 times, ch 5, dc in center ch of ch-5 at next corner of same motif, ch 5, rep from * across to last motif on same side of Stole, dc in center ch of ch-5 sp at corner of last motif on this side, [ch 5, dc in center ch of next ch-7] 3 times, ch 5, [dc, ch 5] twice in center ch of ch-5 at last corner}, rep between {} around, join in top of beg dc. Fasten off.

FRINGE

For each group of Fringe, cut 4 strands of yarn, each 12 inches long. Knot each group in sps on each short edge of Stole.

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
